



The review

- · 12 countries of Eastern Europe, Caucasus and Central Asia
 - Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Republic of Moldova, Russian Federation, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan
- Indicators directly related to migration (5 indicators)
- Indicators that should be disaggregated by migratory status (24 indicators)

Indicators that should be disaggregated by migratory status

TISTICS

- A total of 22 indicators are classified as "for disaggregation -- extended".
- These indicators do not explicitly call for disaggregation by migratory status but are considered relevant in capturing and understanding the condition/situation of migrants in their receiving countries.
- 15 indicators with data available from more than 50% of the countries
 - Eight indicators with data from all the countries
- · Seven indicators with data available from less than 50% of the countries
 - · Two indicators with no data available
- · The data is not disaggregated by migratory status
