

## Proposal to update the GRE-IWG SLR Terms of Reference

This proposal is based on the revised GRE-IWG SLR Terms of Reference, as adopted at the 80<sup>th</sup> GRE session (see Annex II of ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/80). For convenience, all the modifications are indicated in track-change mode.

### I. Proposal

Amend the schedule for the “Stage 2” to read as follows:

### V. Work plan and time schedule

<b>STAGE 2</b>	The overarching objective is to update and harmonize the technical requirements for lighting and light-signalling to be <u>suitable for global implementation under the 1958 and 1998 Agreements</u> .	
<b>STAGE 2 STEP 1</b>	<b>Revise the technical requirements of UN Regulations Nos. 148, 149 and 150</b> , to become technology neutral with performance-based and objective test requirements taking into account glare and visibility.	
	Amendments will also be required to UN Regulation No. 48 taking into account the work of IWG-VGL.	
	Informal submission to the eighty-third session of GRE	<b>October 2020</b>
	Final consideration at the eighty-fifth session of GRE	<b>October 2021</b>
	Adoption by WP.29	<b>June 2022</b>

## II. Justification

### 1. Stage 2 / Step 1

The proposed modifications to the Stage 2 / Step 1 are intended to:

- correctly reflect the actual sessions and dates of GRE and WP.29
- replace the acronyms “LSD, RID, RRD” with the respective UN Regulations numbers
- circumscribe the reference to the IWG-VGL work to the UN Regulation No. 48

### 2. Stage 2 / Step 2

The proposed modifications to the Stage 2 / Step 2 are intended to:

- insert a reference to the continuation of the work on headlamp levelling
- update the target dates for delivering the work

The proposed time extension is necessary in view of the additional time that has been necessary to complete the Stage 2 / Step 1. This was due to the unexpected magnitude of the work and the difficulties and delays caused by the pandemic.
