SIG on UN R48-09 Status Report

- During 85th session of GRE, it was stated that a special interest group would develop requirements for lamps on vehicles in the parked condition, including the so-called «wake-up & shut-down signal» in a global step instead of a 2-step approach (see GRE-85-28).
- At the 5th session of the SIG, Contracting Parties decided to change to a 2-step approach:
 - 1st: to regulate current functions under the parked condition. (to consider the National aspects with some specific requirements).
 - 2nd: to include the use of new lighting functions in the parked condition
- EuroNCAP child protection will be managed separately.
- Development of the proposal (based on SIG-05-08) is still on going.

SIG on UN R48-09 Status Report

Future planning and outlook

- The next session of SIG R48-09 is planned to be held on 10th of June 2022.
- Prepare a working document, the final draft of Step 1 of the SIG for the 87th session of GRE (October 2022).
- In order to avoid the proliferation of new series of amendments, this proposal should preferably be one of the various potential inputs to UN R48-09 (these inputs are: "transition of the device regulations", "Framework provisions for lamps under park condition (Step 1 of SIG R48-09)" and "Headlamp levelling").
