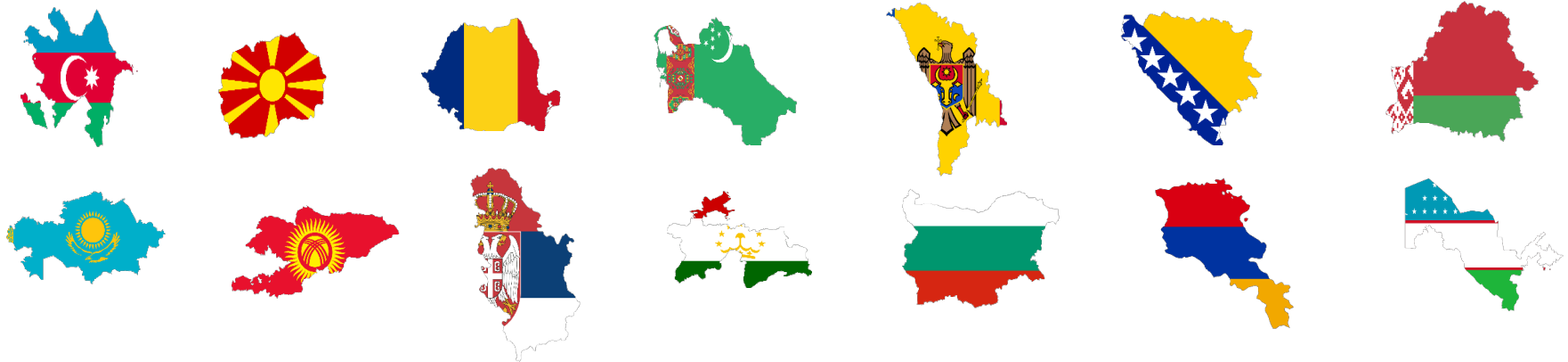

Short term goal: improvement of understanding of **benefits of natural gas in transportation as a low-carbon option**

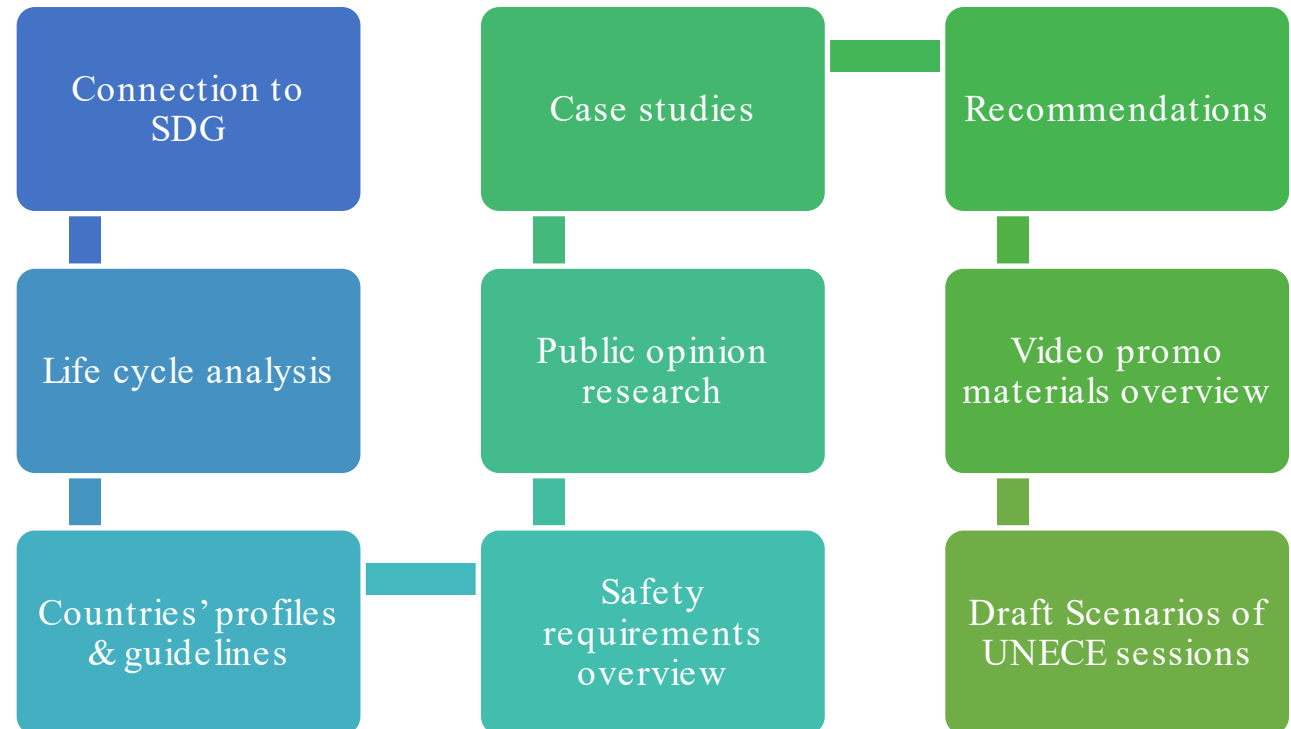

Accelerating post-COVID recovery of Kazakhstan through switching to natural gas in road transport



- Workshop “Support to Decarbonization of Transport in Kazakhstan” 24-25 November 2021
- Further assessment of country economic, environmental and social effects from switching the transport sector to the use of natural gas as a motor fuel
- Assessment of national regulations and steps for their harmonization in accordance with the UN Regulations to ensure uniform and safe technical conditions of gas equipment, facilitate refueling and cross border movements of motor vehicles
