

Following the request of WP.29 at its 186<sup>th</sup> session, GRVA may wish to initiate a review of UN Regulation and UN GTRs under the purview of GRVA, with regards to their fitness for ADS and driverless vehicles.

GRVA may wish to consider any other proposal, if available.

#### 5. Connected vehicles
