Report of the fifth informal session of Group of Experts on Road Signs and Signals

I. Attendance

1. The Group of Experts on Road Signs and Signals (GE.2) held its fifth informal session on 9 May 2022, chaired by Mr. K. Hofman (Belgium). Representatives of the following ECE member States participated: Belgium, Finland, France, Germany, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Portugal, Russian Federation, Sweden and Switzerland.
2. A Representative of non ECE member States: Egypt and the following non-Governmental Organizations were represented: Confederation of Organization in Road Transport (CORTE), Easa Husain Al-Yousifi & Sons Company, International Road Safety Initiative (IROS) and Strasse-Schiene-Verkehr (FSV).

The revised document will contain the corresponding definitions and will be tabled at the next session.
