General segment 17-18 November 2022



- Main decisions and documents to be adopted:
 - Programme of work for 2023-2025
 - Decision on general issues of compliance and election of members of the Compliance Committee
- Topics of discussion, among others:
 - Safe management of water and sanitation
 - Institutional water, sanitation and hygiene
 - Equitable access to water and sanitation
 - Prevention and reduction of water-related diseases

High-level segment 16 November 2022



- Focus: Climate change and COVID-19
- Ministers and heads of agencies are encouraged to take part in-person, or if not online
- Scope of the session:
 - → Appraise progress and take stock of concrete results in attaining and ensuring access to water, sanitation, hygiene and health in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic and in tackling the persisting gaps and challenges caused by climate change in the region.
 - → Discuss the key role of the Protocol on Water and Health in ensuring WASH across countries and sectors in the context of pandemics and in increasing the resilience of WASH and health services to climate change.
- Outcomes: The main conclusions and recommendations will feed into the discussions of the UN Water 2023 Conference planned in March 2023.
