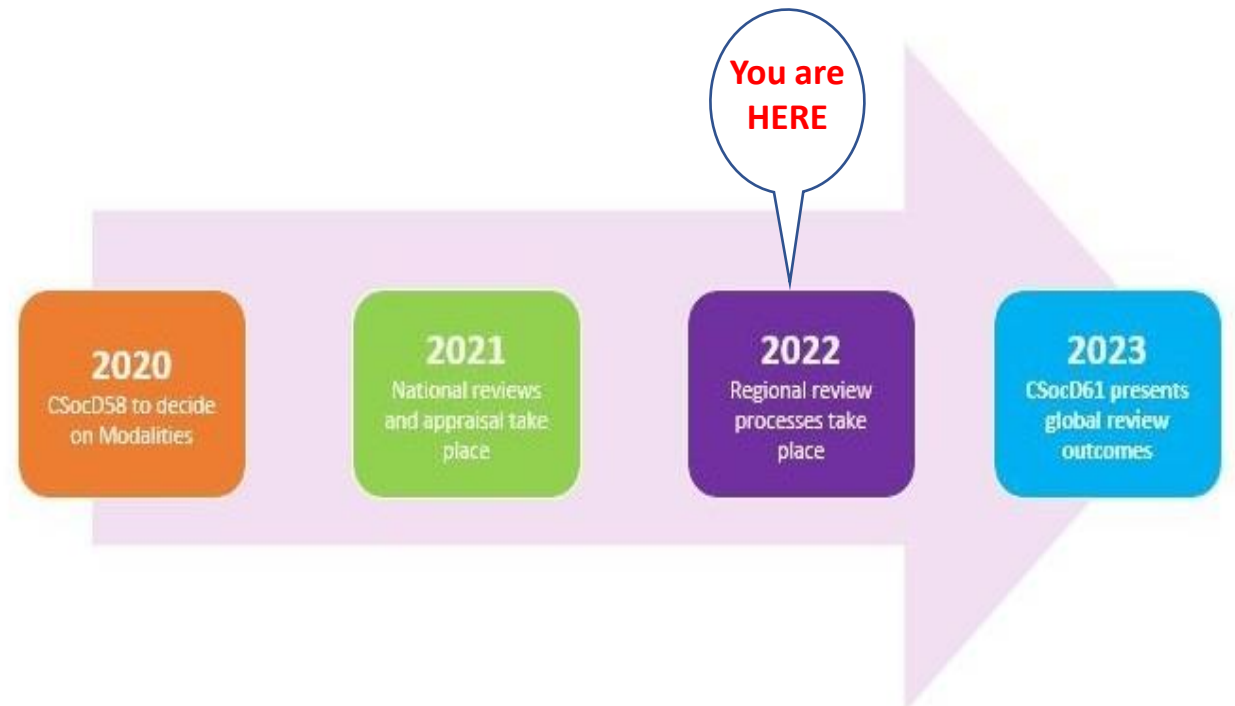


## From Regional To Global

This ensures that the outcomes of intergovernmental processes at the regional level inform the global review at the end of each cycle.

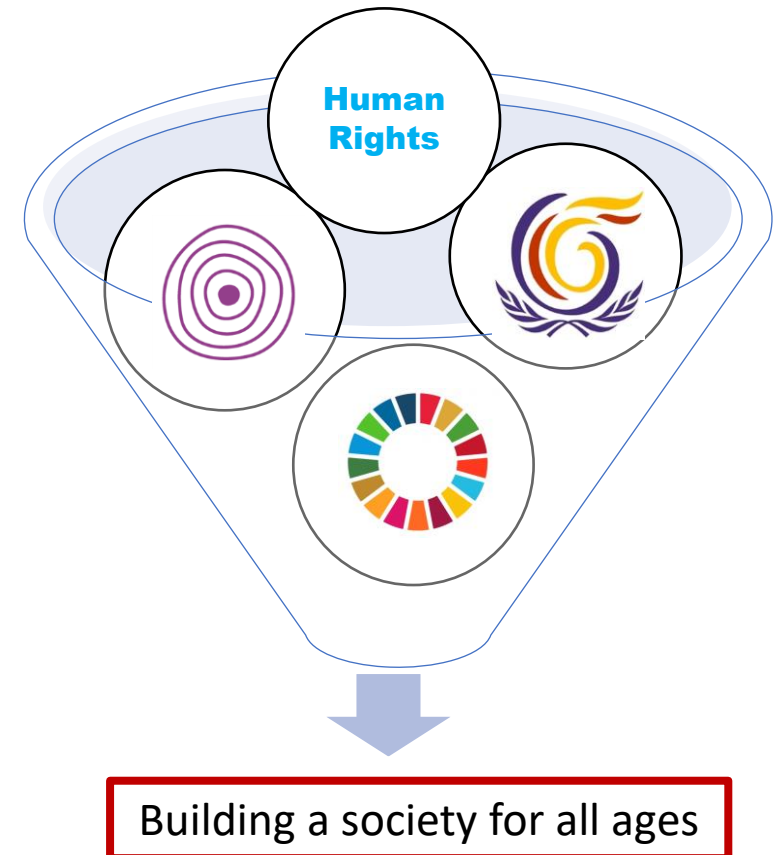




## **20-year milestone: Looking Back, Moving Forward**
