Introduction

1. In the English and French (and possibly Russian) versions, the list of railway vehicles that must comply with the requirements of RID does not correspond to that in the German version.

- 2. In 6.1.4, replace "fixed or demountable tanks" with "demountable tanks".
- 3. Germany invites the secretariat to check the Russian version as well.

II. Justification

4. The proposed amendment is based on consultation with the secretary of the Intergovernmental Organisation for International Carriage by Rail (OTIF) responsible for RID. RID does not mention "fixed tanks".
