# Vision statement UN 2023 Water Conference

“Our watershed moment: uniting the world for water” - 22-24 March 2023, New York

The Netherlands and Tajikistan, as co-hosts, and UNDESA with the support of UN-Water as Secretariat of the Conference will strive to make the Conference *a watershed moment for the world.*

- Three Principles:

- **Inclusive:** both in terms of (a) the Conference process (ensure vertical and horizontal inclusiveness) and in terms of (b) the results (leaving no-one behind).
- **Action-oriented:** the Conference aims to lead to concrete results through concrete actions and plans on the ground.
- **Cross-sectoral:** the Conference should mobilise all other sectors to improve the way they manage and utilize water resources. These sectors need to bring their plans and actions to the Conference.

The Conference will help set the agenda until 2030, and thereafter, in two ways:

1. **Deliver a summary** of the Conference proceedings
  2. **Present a set of voluntary commitments** to get the world back on track
  3. **Roadmap towards 2028 (Decade), 2030 (SDGs) and Agenda post 2030**
- Considering our challenges, there is a need for:
    - Scaled up **finance** and funding by governments, MDBs and private sector;
    - Scaled up and replicated **actions** and best practices;
    - **Innovations** to get the world on track;
    - Follow up UN **conference** on water to mark the results of the decade and the 2023 outcomes;
    - An agenda going **beyond 2030**;
    - **Concluding** in the roadmap and timeline to inspire, unite and guide the world
