The CPD is a critical tool for vehicle imports into Australia

Private Road Vehicles Convention

- Signatory to the PRV Convention since 1967
- Guaranteeing Authority - Australian Automobile Association

Australia's experience with the CPD

Benefits

- A secure, reliable and effective guarantee for Australia's temporary admission procedure.

Challenges




- Eligibility – some vehicles claim temporary admission under Conventions to which Australia is not a party
- Valuation – errors and deliberate undervaluations
- Risk assessment – limited to data or information received either onshore or en-route
- Domestic archiving requirements – retention requirement for 7 years



Digitisation at the border



Digitisation can deliver a simpler, efficient and more secure experience at the border for both Customs and Industry.

Pre-arrival notification and system integration



Pre-arrival notification

- Shifting risks offshore – benefits for Customs and industry
- Reduce post-border compliance through effective pre-border intervention
- Further enhance trade facilitation outcomes for low-risk carnets (e.g. trusted traders)

System integration



- Harmonised, but flexible, datasets
- Seamless dataflow between global and domestic systems
- Alignment with domestic and global data and privacy rules
- Following best practice in cyber protection across the eCPD system
