I write to let you know that, out of fairness to both the Party concerned and the communicant, in the light of the ongoing war against Ukraine, the Committee proposes to further postpone the session on preliminary admissibility of communication PRE/ACCC/C/2022/191 until its 76th meeting on 13-16 September 2022, unless both the Party concerned and the communicant consider themselves in a position to be able to proceed to discuss the preliminary admissibility of the communication at the Committee's 75th meeting next week from 14-17 June.

If you consider that you are in a position to proceed with the open session on preliminary admissibility on Tuesday, 14 June, I would be grateful if you would let me know by **close of business this Friday, 10 June**. Otherwise, the Committee will proceed to postpone the session on preliminary admissibility until its 76th meeting.
