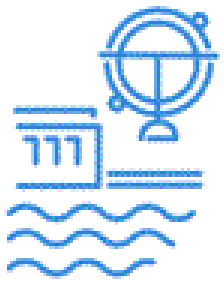

# Programme of Work for 2022-2024



## Main areas of work

- **Area 1:** Supporting monitoring, assessment and information sharing in transboundary basins
- **Area 2:** Promoting an integrated and cross-sectoral approach to water resources management at all levels
- **Area 3:** Reporting on SDG 6.5.2 and implementation of the Convention



## Supporting monitoring, assessment and information sharing in transboundary basins



Development of joint measures to prevent and respond to pollution of the Syr Darya river basin in emergency situations

- Phase I, at the support of the European Union in cooperation with the UNECE
- Analysis of potential sources of pollution, accidental pollution risks, existing information exchange, early warning system and cooperation of riparian countries in case of accidental pollution, mapping most hazardous facilities posing risks of accidental pollution, development of joint recommendations;
- Phase II - Joint Contingency Plan for Syrdarya

Assistance in updating guidance materials on monitoring, assessment and information sharing

- Regional workshop on monitoring, assessment and information sharing in transboundary basins in Central Asia - to develop recommendations on the guidance materials of the Convention (funding is requested).
- *Recommendations of the Regional training workshop on improving hydrometeorological services in Central Asia, November 2021, at the support of Slovak Government and EU*



# Promoting an integrated and cross-sectoral approach to water resources management at all levels

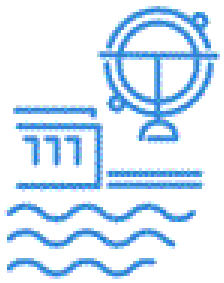


## **Assistance in the safe management of hydraulic structures**

- Study tour to strengthen the institutional capacity of specialized national dam safety authorities in Central Asia, in September 2022, Bratislava, Slovakia
- Regional workshop on the safety of hydraulic structures in Central Asia, in November 2022, Almaty, Kazakhstan
- At the support of World Bank and the Slovak Government in cooperation with Slovak technical water related organizations (Vodohospodarska vystavba, Slovak HMI and MicroStep)

## **Application of Handbook on Water Allocation in a Transboundary Context**

- Regional workshop on water allocation in a transboundary context in Central Asia, in October 2022, Almaty, Kazakhstan - at the support of the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry of Finland and Finnish Environment Institute (SYKE)

- Case study on assessment of the role of water in development of economies of Central Asian countries based on the example of Kazakhstan (funding is required)

- Regional workshop on sharing experiences in using reports as a tool for developing transboundary cooperation and developing road maps on indicator 6.5.2. (funding is required)
