As anticipated in the EU's (draft) action plan for compliance under MOP request ACCC/M/2021/4 (submitted to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee on 1 July 2022), we would like to inform you that the European Commission has now launched a public consultation to help inform the EU's reflections on the implications of the Committee's findings in case ACCC/C/2015/128 on state aid and on possible options for addressing this issue.
