Proposal for Supplement 1 to the 04 series of amendments to UN Regulation No. 118 (Burning behaviour of materials)

Submitted by the Working Party on General Safety Provisions*

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on General Safety Provisions (GRSG) at its 123rd session (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/102, para. 8). It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/2022/2 not amended. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration at their November 2022 sessions.

* In accordance with the programme of work of the Inland Transport Committee for 2022 as outlined in proposed programme budget for 2022 (A/76/6 (part V sect. 20) para 20.76), the World Forum will develop, harmonize and update UN Regulations in order to enhance the performance of vehicles. The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.



Insert a new paragraph 1.1.1., to read:

"1.1.1. At the request of the manufacturer, this UN Regulation may also be applied to vehicles of Categories M₃, Class I."

Part II, insert a new paragraph 6.1.9., to read:

"6.1.9. "Plastic glazing" is a glazing material that contains as an essential ingredient, one or more organic polymeric substances of large molecular weight, is solid in its finished state and, at some stage in its manufacture or processing into finished articles, can be shaped by flow."

Part II, paragraph 6.2.7.1., amend to read:

"6.2.7.1. Parts made of metal or glass; Parts made of plastic glazing are not included in this exemption."
