1	1	ECE/TRANS/WP.1/GE.3/2022/4	The Group of Experts adopted the provisional agenda prepared for this session.
2	2	ECE/TRANS/WP.1/GE.3/2022/6 ECE/TRANS/WP.1/GE.3/2022/7 ECE/TRANS/WP.1/GE.3/2022/8	<p>The Group welcomed the documents (and the corresponding presentations introducing them), prepared by the secretariat on request of the Group, briefing the Group about activities of other Inland Transport Committee working parties and relevant groups related to automated vehicles, on the history of Conventions related to road traffic and traffic safety, as well as on relevant terms and definitions.</p> <p>The Group agreed to consider them as reference documents for further activities.</p>
2	3		The Group of Experts requested the secretariat to provide information on the status of the discussions within WP.29, regarding the need for light signalling for vehicles equipped with an ADS, when the ADS is switched on, at its December 2022 session.
3	4		<p>The Group discussed its modus operandi to organize the work in between the formal sessions, and decided on the following:</p> <p>The experts from Finland, Malta, the Netherlands, Poland, Sweden and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland volunteered to initiate drafting activities, considering among other items listed in Presentation 3, slides 3, 4 and 5, keeping in mind the specific aim to ensure road safety, in particular the safety of vulnerable road users.</p> <p>The experts from France, Germany and Luxembourg also expressed interest in participating in this drafting exercise. They announced that they would confirm their participation after the session.</p> <p>The Group agreed that the volunteers would meet independently and that the experts from Finland (and potentially from the Netherlands) would support that process as main point(s) of contact.</p>

3	5		The Group agreed with the proposal by the Chair to issue a standing invitation to other stakeholders to the sessions of WP.1/GE.3 until the end of its first term.
4	6		The Group of Experts reviewed this document and endorsed it.
5	7	ECE/TRANS/WP.1/GE.3/2022/2	The Group of Experts adopted the report prepared after the third session in May 2022.
6	8		The Group noted that the fifth session of the Group of Experts is scheduled to take place on 12 December 2022.
