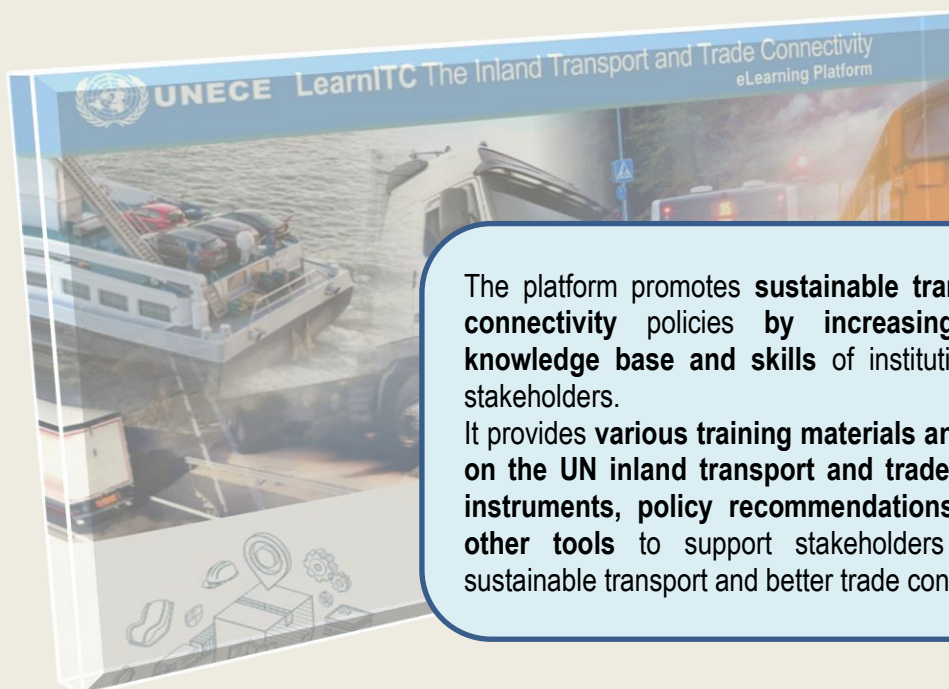

I. About the eLearning platform:

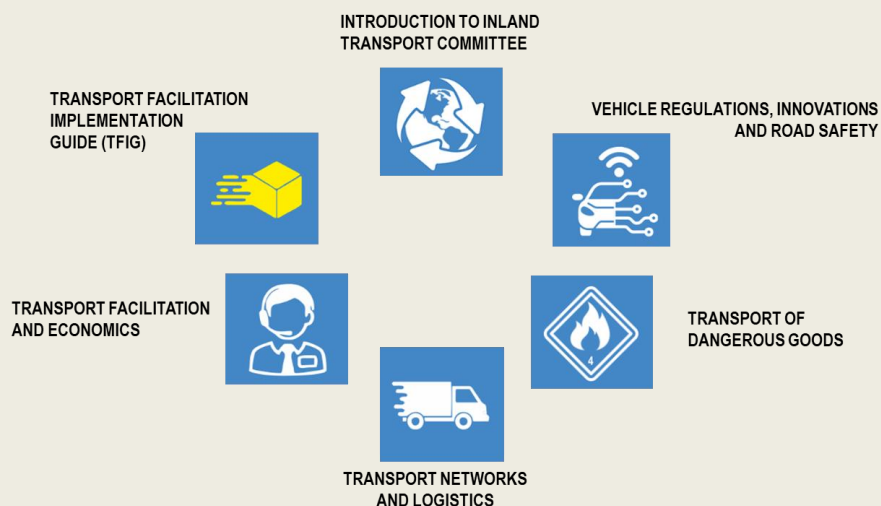


The platform promotes **sustainable transport and trade connectivity** policies by **increasing the capacity, knowledge base and skills** of institutional and sectoral stakeholders.
