

Insert a new paragraph 1.10., to read:

"1.10. Vehicles approved in accordance with the provisions of Regulation No. 161 on Unauthorized Use are deemed to comply with Part I of this Regulation. Vehicles approved in accordance with the provisions of Regulation No. 163 on Alarm System are deemed to comply with Part III of this Regulation. Vehicles approved in accordance with the provisions of Regulation No. 162 on Immobilizer are deemed to comply with Part IV of this Regulation."
