Abstract

The presentation refers to Georgia's 2030 Climate Change Strategy, that represents a planning and implementation mechanism for coordinated effort and planning towards meeting the nationally determined targets for climate change mitigation. Climate Change Strategy and Action Plan set out the national climate change mitigation policy in the following sectors: Energy Generation and Transmission, Energy Consumption in Transport, Energy Consumption in Buildings, Energy Consumption in Industry and Industrial Processes, Agriculture, Waste Management and Forestry as well. Each sector has relevant indicators, targets and statistical data.
