Plans and innovations for 2024 PHC

 In order to increase the quality (reliability and completeness), as well as to reduce the deadlines for data processing and dissemination in the next RPL, it is envisaged to use modern technologies and new data collection methods




- Collection method CAWI, CAPI
- Duration 30 days (CAWI), 60 (CAPI);
- Electronic devices tablets or smartphones;
- Use of administrative data for prefilled questions;
- Use of the geographic information system (GIS) at the stage of preparing the RPL, collecting data and disseminating the results.

Development and adoption of the PHC law



2019-2022

- Draft Law on the population and housing census, round 2020 -> based on the previous Law 90/2012 on PHC 2014 and evaluation report of PHC 2014, supported by UNFPA in 2017;
- Normative acts of the Albania, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Canada, Czech Republic, Estonia, Georgia, Great Britain, Israel, Romania, Russian Federation, Ukraine were studied;
- International Recommendations both EU and UN were studied;
- In 2020 a Generic Law on the Population and Housing Census was drafted instead of the specific law;
- During the International Technical Advisory Board meeting the draft law was consulted with international experts;
- Discussions within NBS Working Group (WG) on censuses;



It was published in the Official Gazette on the 26th of August 2022 and will be in force starting from 26th of September 2022.

Harmonization with EU Regulation (EC) no. STATISTICA POLL 763/2008



LAW No. 90 as of 26.04.2012

on population and housing census of the Republic of Moldova in 2014

This law transposed **Regulation (EC) no.**

763/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of the European Union of 9 July 2008 on the population and housing census and ensured the necessary framework for its application

It **transposed** the definition of usual residence and the Annex with topics of the regulation

Law no. 231 as of 28 July 2022 **GENERIC LAW** on population and housing census





Concept of Automated Information System



Goal of AIS

Establishment of single and modern framework for statistics on population and housing census, demography, migration to ensure that Moldova has reliable, detailed and comparable data on the size and the demographic, social, employment, housing, educational and migratory characteristics of the population.

Benefits:

- ✓ Further harmonization of concepts and population definitions, stocks and flows;
- ✓ More information about migration flows;
- ✓ More information on population groups related to migration and such as foreign-born and foreign citizens,
- ✓ Increased geographical detail in the statistics available.
- ✓ Improvements in frequency, efficiency of production, timeliness and coherence of population statistics.

Develop full and detailed communication and visibility campaign strategy



Development of pilot tests program



Development of the quality management program of census operations

Census CONDUCT and POST-CENSUS activities 2022-2026



2022-2023

- Develop the IT system for the census with the following modules:
 - Data protection system
 - Monitoring census logistics
 - Field data collection by enumerators and with participation of supervisors
 - Reporting and monitoring of census enumeration
- Develop all the necessary census tools (manuals for different staff, procedures for enumeration etc.)
- Implement the pilot tests program
- Planning the dissemination of the results
- Develop census evaluation program
- Gradually implement the quality management program of census operations

2024

- Field enumeration within the general census
- Field enumeration of the post enumeration survey

2025-2026

- Data processing
- Data dissemination
- Data communication
- Final reports




