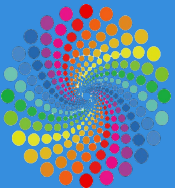
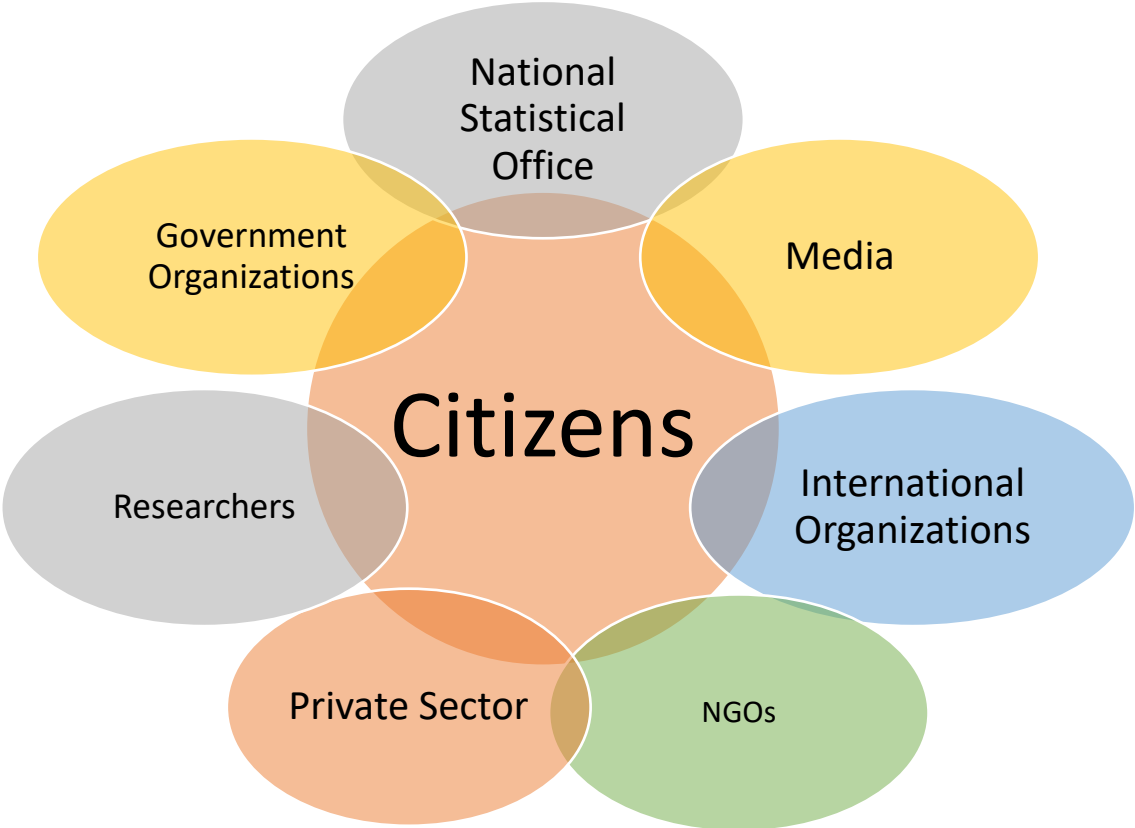

Statistical organizations engage with & provide information to a variety of audiences



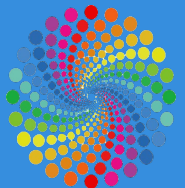
Directly – through targeted releases

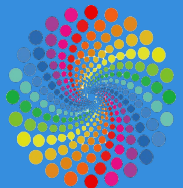

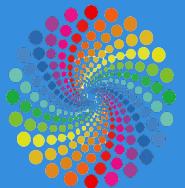
