### "COFFI Market Discussions 2022"

# 03 November 2022 – 15:00-18:00 CET Salle XXI – Palais des Nations Geneva, Switzerland

This document details the planning for Item 5 "Forest economics and markets" of the annotated provisions agenda for the eightieth session of the Committee on Forests and the Forest Industry (COFFI). The proposed structure and setup are the outcome of the secretariat's consultation with the Core Group of the UNECE/FAO Team of Specialists on Sustainable Forest Products.

The Market Discussion will be moderated by **Professor Chris Gaston** (University of British Columbia, Canada) and consist of two main segments:

Segment I: "Recent trends and possible near future market

developments of key wood-based commodities"

Segment II: "Selected policy measures and their possible medium to long term impacts on wood markets"

Member States are invited to make statements on the main issues and developments in their forest products' markets and contribute to the discussion by specifically addressing the following issues:

- (a) Raw material supply security;
- (b) Wood in construction;
- (c) Biotic and abiotic disturbances of forests, their impacts on forest products markets and trade, and current and planned policy measures taken by countries to mitigate economic and ecologic impacts;
- (d) Forests and the forest-based industries in a circular bioeconomy;
- (e) Renewable energy policies and their impacts on forest products markets

The UNECE/FAO Forestry and Timber Section will use the outcome of the COFFI market discussions to amend the draft COFFI Market Statement and review the amendments with a drafting group.
