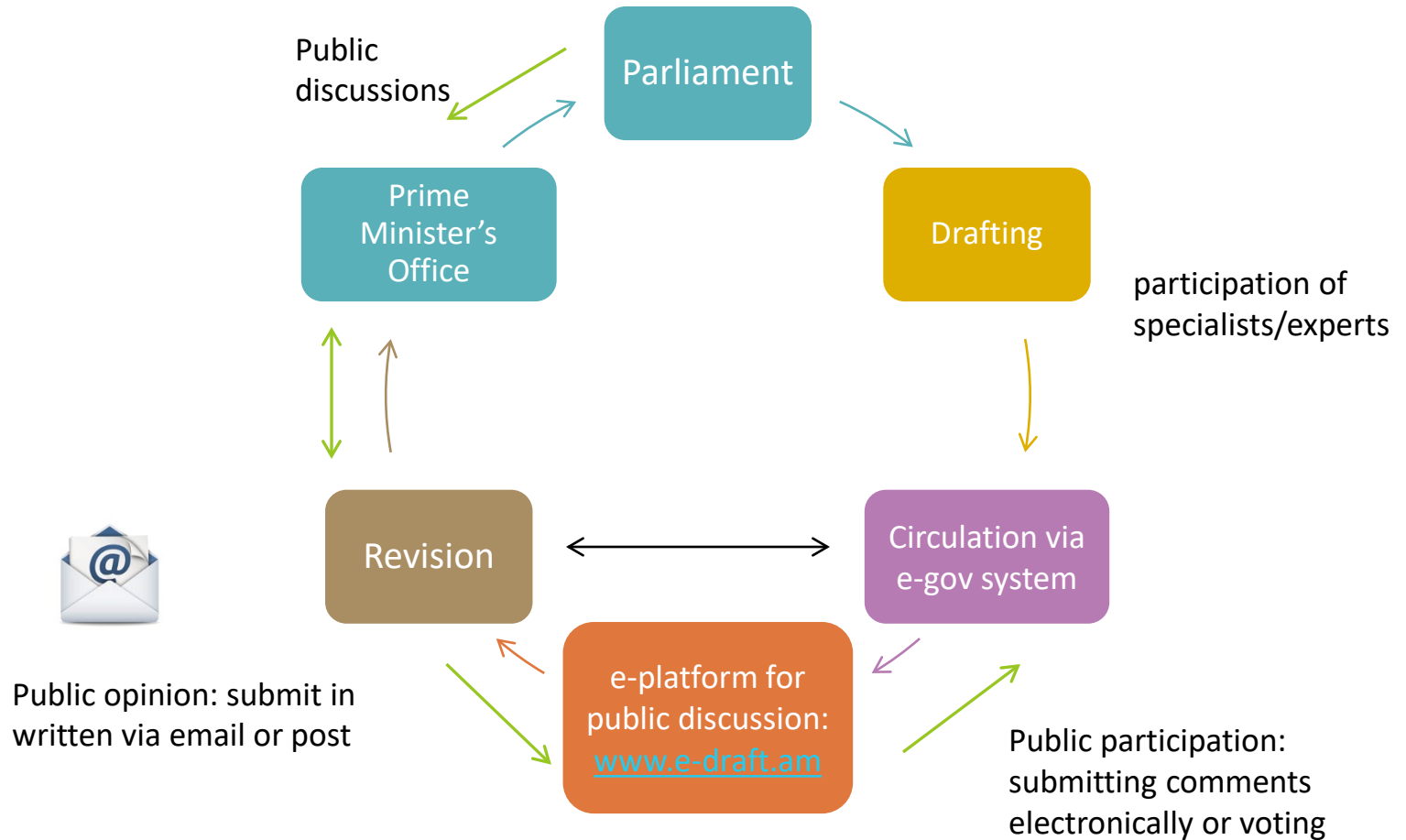

a natural hydrographic monument of Armenia since 2008



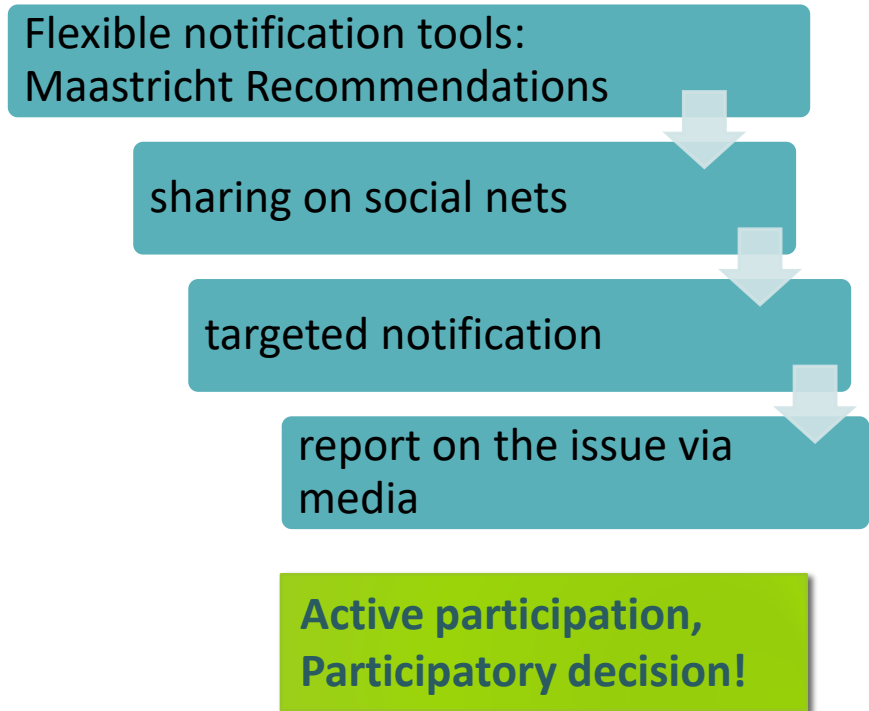
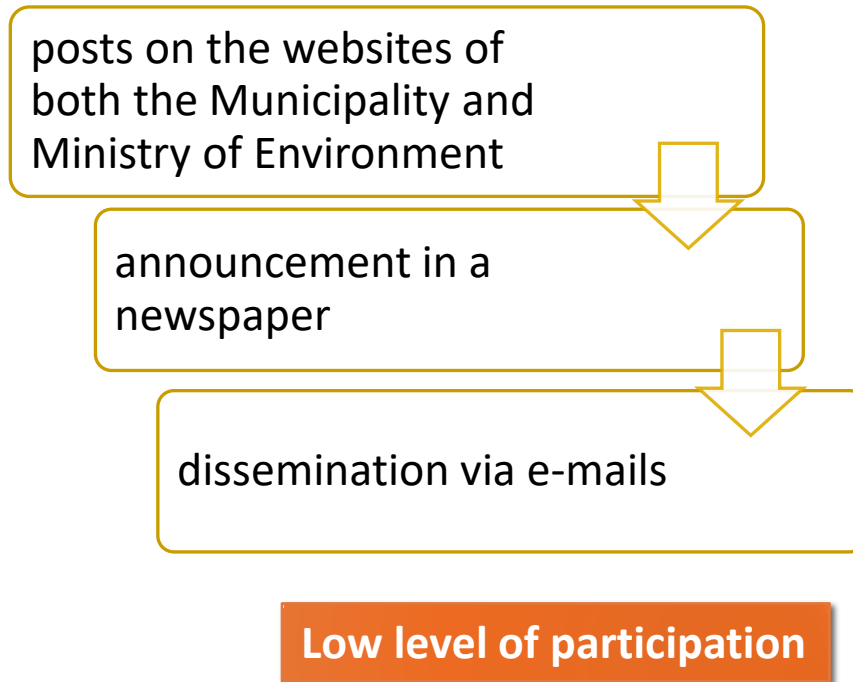
