#### Summary

The present document contains draft decisions for consideration and adoption by the Executive Body.


The Executive Body is invited to adopt the following documents approved by the Steering Body to the Cooperative Programme for Monitoring and Evaluation of the Longrange Transmission of Air Pollutants in Europe and the Working Group on Effects at their eighth joint session (Geneva, 12–16 September 2022):

- (a) Guidelines for Reporting Emissions and Projections Data under the Convention on Long-range Transboundary Air Pollution;
- (b) Technical Guidance for Emission Inventory Adjustments under the Amended Gothenburg Protocol;
- (c) Strategy for scientific bodies under the Convention on Long-range Transboundary Air Pollution.

The Executive Body is invited to amend appendix II to decision 2002/1 on the financing of core activities updating the scale of contributions in accordance with the United Nations 2021 assessment rate.

The Executive Body is also invited to consider the proposal by its Bureau to establish the practice of a declaration of impartiality by officials elected by the Executive Body, following the request by the Executive Body at its forty-first session (Geneva, 6–8 December 2021).<sup>a</sup>

## I. Adoption of the Guidelines for Reporting Emissions and Projections Data under the Convention on Long-range Transboundary Air Pollution

The Executive Body,

*Recognizing* the need for guidance on reporting emissions and projections to ensure reliable emission data both for the purpose of reviewing Parties' compliance with their obligations under the protocols and as a basis for scientific work to further develop abatement strategies under the Convention,

Referring to the Guidelines for Reporting Emissions and Projections Data under the Convention on Long-range Transboundary Air Pollution approved by the Steering Body to the Cooperative Programme for Monitoring and Evaluation of the Long-range Transmission of Air Pollutants in Europe and the Working Group on Effects at their eighth joint session (Geneva, 12–16 September 2022),

Adopts the Guidelines contained in document ECE/EB.AIR/GE.1/2022/20–ECE/EB.AIR/WG.1/2022/13.

## II. Adoption of the Technical Guidance for Emission Inventory Adjustments under the Amended Gothenburg Protocol

The Executive Body,

*Referring* to article 3 (11 quinquies) of the Protocol to Abate Acidification, Eutrophication and Ground-level Ozone (Gothenburg Protocol), as amended in 2012,

Recalling its decisions:

- (a) 2012/3 on adjustments under the Gothenburg Protocol to emission reduction commitments or to inventories for the purposes of comparing total national emissions with them.<sup>1</sup>
- (b) 2012/12 on the Guidance for adjustments under the 1999 Protocol to Abate Acidification, Eutrophication and Ground-level Ozone to emission reduction commitments or to inventories for the purposes of comparing total national emissions with them,
- (c) 2014/1 on improving the guidance for adjustments under the 1999 Protocol to Abate Acidification, Eutrophication and Ground-level Ozone to emission reduction commitments or to inventories for the purposes of comparing total national emissions with them,
- (d) 2019/2 on review of compliance by Parties to the Protocol to Abate Acidification, Eutrophication and Ground-level Ozone (Gothenburg Protocol),

*Recognizing* the need for guidance to support Parties applying for adjustments with respect to their emission reduction commitments under the Gothenburg Protocol, as amended in 2012,

Adopts the Technical Guidance for Emission Inventory Adjustments under the Amended Gothenburg Protocol approved by the Steering Body to the Cooperative Programme for Monitoring and Evaluation of the Long-range Transmission of Air Pollutants in Europe and the Working Group on Effects at their eighth joint session (Geneva, 12–16 September 2022) and contained in document (ECE/EB.AIR/GE.1/2022/21–ECE/EB.AIR/WG.1/2022/14).

# III. Adoption of the strategy for scientific bodies under the Convention on Long-range Transboundary Air Pollution

The Executive Body,

*Recalling* the revised strategy for the Cooperative Programme for Monitoring and Evaluation of the Long-range Transmission of Air Pollutants in Europe for 2010–2019 (ECE/EB.AIR/2009/16/Rev.1²),

*Recalling also* the revised long-term strategy of the effects-oriented activities (ECE/EB.AIR/2009/17/Rev.1<sup>3</sup>),

*Recognizing* the achievements of the science work under the Convention over the past 10 years,

Recognizing also the need to update the above-mentioned strategies of the scientific bodies in order to set out a vision for scientific work and priorities for the period 2022–2030 and beyond, so to support implementation of the long-term strategy for the Convention for 2020–2030 and beyond (decision 2018/5)<sup>4</sup> and provide the technical and scientific background to support the implementation of the protocols to the Convention,

Adopts the strategy for scientific bodies under the Convention on Long-range Transboundary Air Pollution approved by the Steering Body to the Cooperative Programme for Monitoring and Evaluation of the Long-range Transmission of Air Pollutants in Europe and the Working Group on Effects at their eighth joint session (Geneva, 12–16 September 2022) and contained in document ECE/EB.AIR/2022/10.

*Recalling* the rules of procedure for sessions of the Executive Body, as adopted by decision 2010/19<sup>3</sup> and amended by decision 2013/1, in particular sections VII and VIII of the annex to decision 2010/19,

*Cognizant* of the need for the elected officers of the Executive Body and the members of the Implementation Committee to exercise their duties in an impartial manner, avoiding actual, potential and perceived conflicts of interest,

- 1. Requests all officers and members of the Implementation Committee newly elected by the Executive Body to sign the impartiality declaration as contained in the annex to the present decision prior to assuming their duties;
- 2. *Encourages* its subsidiary bodies to establish a similar practice for their newly elected Chairs and Vice-Chairs.
