I hope you are well.

In your email of 29 July 2022, you explained that, due to government restructuring following the April election, there would be a small delay in the submission of Hungary's plan of action on decision VII/8h, which the Meeting of the Parties had requested Hungary to submit to the Compliance Committee by 1 July 2022.

I write to inform you that the Compliance Committee is presently engaged in the process of reviewing all plans of actions of Parties subject to a MOP decision on compliance and intends to complete its review of all Parties' plans of actions in the next few weeks.

In order that Hungary's plan of action can be considered by the Committee in its review, the Committee looks forward to receive Hungary's plan of action, or else to be informed of the date by when it can expect to receive the plan of action, as soon as possible.
