This document aims to complete the proposal for the 04 series of amendments to UN Regulation No. 117 which was adopted by the Working Party on Noise and Tyres (GRBP) in September 2022 and will be submitted to the March 2023 session of the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29). The modifications are marked in bold for new or strikethrough for deleted characters.

## I. Proposal

*Paragraph 2.18., subparagraph (c), amend to read:*

"2.18. ...  
(c) [~~F####-##~~] **F3611-22** for the size P225/60R16 in worn state and referred to as "moulded SRTT16 worn",  
..."

## II. Justification

As explained by the experts from IWG WGWT at the seventy-sixth session of GRBP in September 2022, a detailed reference for the molded standard reference test tyre (SRTT16) was not available at that time yet. It is now introduced as F3611-22.
