Kathryn Lundquist is an economic affairs officer in the Economic Research and Statistics Division of the World Trade Organization. As part of her duties, Kathryn supports the WTO Micro-, Small- and Medium-Sized Enterprise (MSME) Informal Working Group through research on MSMEs and trade-related topics such as MSME references in regional trade agreements or small business and climate change. In 2021 she also helped the Group develop the new Trade4MSMEs web platform, an online resource for MSMEs and policymakers.

In other parts of her work, Kathryn has focused on MSME digitalization and small business participation in global value chains (GVCs). This has included research related to e-commerce, MSMEs and developing economy participation in trade and global value chains. Kathryn has also authored chapters in the 2019 and 2021 GVC Development Reports on the Digital Economy, GVCs and SMEs and Digital Platforms and Global Value Chains.
