






Expenditures spent by inbound visitors










Distribution of expenditures spent by outbound visitors in 2019, %





Number of outbound visits by visited countries in 2019





Forest resources and their protection

Protected areas

- Structure of protected areas
- Number of preserved animal and bird species
- Expenses on maintenance of protected areas and number of employees

Water Resources

- Main rivers, lakes and reservoirs
- Main indicators for water supply industry and wastewater collection
- Main indicators for protection and use of water resources

Ambient air protection

- Generated, decontaminated and emitted hazardous substances from stationary sources
- Exhaust emissions from road transport



- Revision and update of the relevant legislation

















Trend of Visitors to the Protected Areas






