  - Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Republic of Moldova, Russian Federation, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan
- SDG Indicators: **1.1.1, 1.2.1, 1.2.2, 1.3.1, 1.4.1, 10.1.1, 10.2.1**
- Availability by various disaggregation
- Data coverage and latest available period
- Review based on data reported to Global SDG Database (as of 17 October 2022)

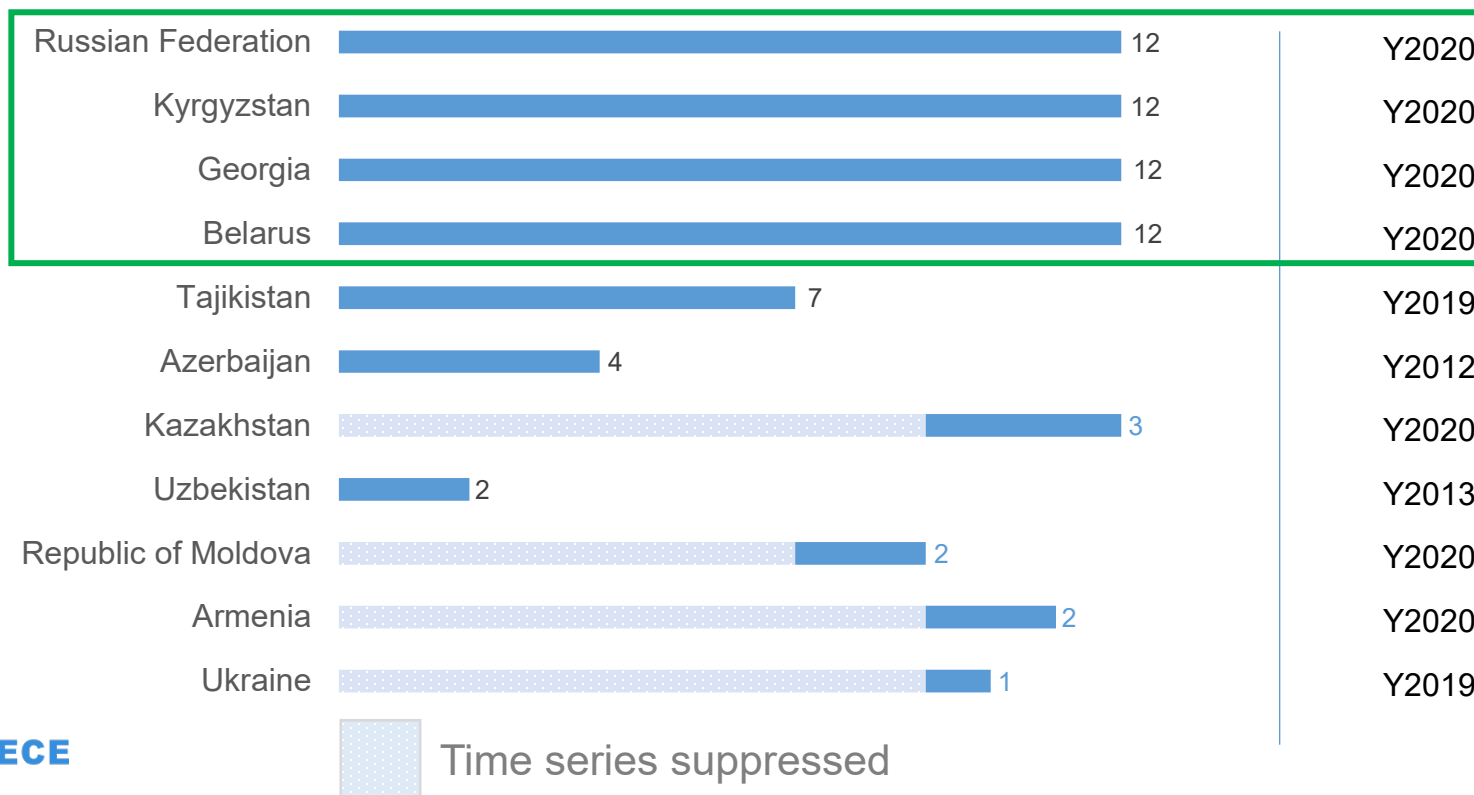

  - Age disaggregation: <18 years old

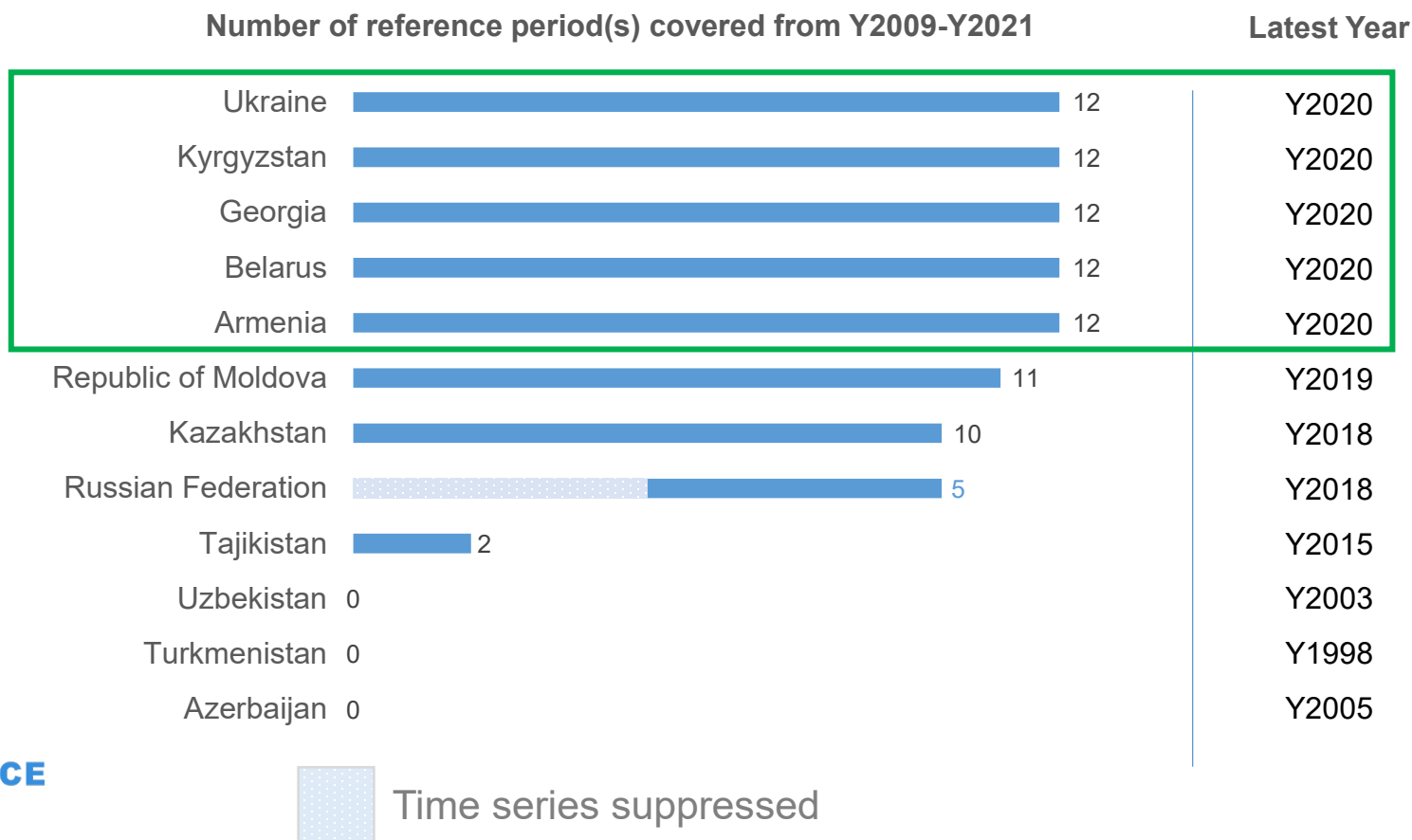
## 10.2.1 - Proportion of people living below 50 per cent of median income

  - Good coverage with more recent data from Y2020 and more data disaggregation
  - For employed population: all 12 countries with more recent data
- **1.2.2 - Multidimensional poverty**
  - Currently one country with data for indicator
- Improved data availability for **1.3.1 and 10.1.1**
- Countries with more recent data from Y2020 for indicator **10.2.1**
- Major update to the global database expected towards end of  
December 2022
