WGSR 60: organisation

- WGSR 60 took place in a hybrid mode from 11-14 April 2022 (Geneva)
- Continued to advance policy aspects of 2022-2023 workplan
- Focus on Gothenburg Protocol review
- Recommended that a second WGSR meeting be planned in 2023 for discussions on the follow-up to GP Review conclusions taking into consideration the timing of WGSR meeting(s); Recommended that the EB requests Parties to contribute to financing of such a meeting in 2023 (see agenda item 5, Wednesday/Thursday)
- Discussed key issues to be addressed at the informal Heads of Delegation meeting (see separate presentation)

Information exchange and Task Force Reports

- Information-sharing by Parties on the implementation of the Convention: Reports submitted by Austria, Cyprus, Finland, Greece, Lithuania, North Macedonia, Poland, Republic of Moldova and Serbia were summarised by the WGSR Bureau and presented by the secretariat
- Reports by the Task Force on Techno-Economic Issues, Task Force on Reactive Nitrogen and Task Force on Integrated Assessment Modelling – all of which contributed strongly to the Gothenburg Protocol review (see agenda item 5, Wednesday/Thursday)
- Information on the Task Force on International Cooperation on Air Pollution on its plans for activities in 2022–2023

Cost of Inaction Report

- Costs of emission abatement are very often much lower than costs of no emission abatement.
- Draft report (ECE/EB.AIR/WG.5/2022/4), prepared by the Task Force on Integrated Assessment Modelling in cooperation with the Task Force on Techno-economic Issues, was discussed. Various Parties had submitted comments in writing and provided additional comments at the meeting.
- The Working Group agreed to forward the finalised version, taking into account the comments received, to the Executive Body for consideration at this forty-second session.
- Final draft available as ECE/EB.AIR/2022/7

Broader geographic cooperation

- First meeting of the Task Force on International Cooperation on Air Pollution in Bristol (UK), 11-12 October 2022
- First meeting of the Forum on international Cooperation will take place on 16 March 2023 in Göteborg, Sweden...
- Based on work by TFIAM and TFHTAP, WGSR will discuss the implications of future global and regional emissions scenarios, particularly regarding (but not limited to) methane and shipping emissions (see GP review documents to be discussed under agenda item 5, Wednesday/Thursday)

2023: Draft Guidance Documents and Policy Briefs (I)

- Draft guidance documents on <u>methane mitigation technologies</u> and on the <u>abatement of shipping emissions</u> is being prepared by the Task Force on Techno-economic Issues, and will be discussed by WGSR in 2023.
- If Parties agree to finalise these documents based on their comments, the Working Group may wish to forward the finalised version to the Executive Body for consideration at this forty-third session.

2023: Draft Guidance Documents and Policy Briefs (II)

- A draft guidance document on <u>non-technical and structural</u> <u>measures</u> and a policy brief on <u>multilevel governance</u> will be drafted by the Task Force on Integrated Assessment Modelling in cooperation with other bodies.
- A policy brief / guidance document on the <u>co-mitigation of methane</u> <u>and ammonia</u> (and other reactive nitrogen) <u>emissions</u> is being prepared in cooperation between the Task Forces on Technoeconomic Issues and on Reactive Nitrogen.
- These will be discussed by WGSR in 2023, with a view for consideration by the Executive Body at its forty-third session.

2023: Review of the Rules of Procedure

2023: Options for a policy follow-up to the GP review

- The finalisation of the review of the Gothenburg Protocol as amended has been a strong emphasis of WGSR work in 2022.
- Further work and its organisation depends on a decision by this session of the Executive Body on the finalization of the GP Review (agenda item 5)
- This might entail the need to develop policy options on the basis of the review conclusions for consideration by the Executive Body at its 43rd session
