

- Complete and launch I4SD Reviews of Armenia and Ukraine
- Complete and launch an Interim IPO for Eastern Europe and the South Caucasus

Technical Cooperation

- Deliver capacity building in follow-up to the I4SDRs of Moldova and Uzbekistan
- Deliver sub-regional and national capacity building to implement the SPECA Innovation Strategy for Sustainable Development
- Complete and launch handbooks on "Supporting High-Growth Innovative Enterprises in the SPECA Region" and "Innovation Policy for Transition Economies"

Fundraising

• Raise XB funds to respond to member State requests, e.g. for an IPO for countries in Central Asia and the Western Balkans; national I4SDRs; capacity building work

Evaluation Methodology

 Support Governments in self-assessing their PPP projects using the PPP Evaluation Methodology for the SDGs



- Finalise Guidelines on promoting Circular Economy in PPPs for the SDGs
- Develop guidelines on PPPs for the SDGs and digital transformation, sustainable and green PPP procurement, and other focus areas as agreed by the CICPPP
- Finalise work on PPP/Concession Model Law



• Deliver national, regional, and sub-regional activities in a number of countries



• Continue campaign to collect 500 case studies on PPPs for the SDGs









Cooperation with other UNECE bodies & international organizations



- Contributions to the 70th session of ECE on Green & Digital Transformations and to the 2023 European Regional Forum on Sustainable Development
- For IPO and I4SD review, continued and growing partnership with, e.g. WIPO, EC (JRC, H2020), OECD, IOM, UNRCO offices and UNDP
- Cooperation with ESCAP in framework SPECA (e.g. Action Plan of SPECA Innovation Strategy for Sustainable Development)
- Cooperation with the UN: UN Inter-Agency Task Team on Science Technology and Innovation
- Cooperation with other four Regional Commissions, UN DESA, and UNCTAD in a capacity building project to promote effective partnerships between the public and private sector in countries
- Cooperation with UNDP, WHO, UNICEF and UNRCO in Ukraine on capacity building for public officials in Ukraine to develop and implement People-first PPPs in support of SDGs
- Cooperation with the Secretariat of the CIS Interparliamentary Assembly, to promote international legal PPP best practices in the CIS region
