


E-charging facility (station or point)

As discussed in the last session of GE.2 on 3rd and 4th November 2022, the Symbol with image content 'electric plug with cord' (Figure B1, right) is proposed to represent the meaning of "e-charging facility, station or point" (final description of the meaning pending).



Accordingly, there are possibilities for how a facility only for e-charging could be signalled. B1a) uses an additional panel, with sign F, 4, B1b) places the symbol B1) on the lower part of the blue ground, which reflects the proposed usage of the lower part in B2a and B2b (below).

Alternative B1c) (right) places the symbol within the white square, reducing the amount of information on the F-sign.





Alternative fuels on sign F, 4, including e-charging

Figure B2a) and B2b) proposes the use of fuel indications on the lower part of the blue ground. As discussed in the last session of GE.2 on 3rd and 4th November 2022, the character "plus" (+) identifies the fuel indications to be additional to the regular fuels to be found on a fuel station. The two depictions of sign F, 4 are practically the same, only to show the possibility to mix abbreviation-based fuel identifications made of text, with symbol B1), since the symbol is more legible than letters (text).





Electric vehicle

In order to represent any electric vehicle through a symbol (B3, right), it seems obvious to combine the meaning of 'car in front view' as used in the Convention in various signs (e.g. C, 3a, C, 4a, C, 4b, E, 6a etc) with symbol B1) 'electric plug with cord'. In order to clarify the aspect of "electric" and provide best-possible legibility (discriminability), 'plug and cord' is magnified beyond actual proportion.

Figure B3a) presents the use of an additional panel with a parking restriction, allowing only electric vehicles to park.
