




The Italian National review and appraisal process

- The Fourth Appraisal Cycle of the MIPAA/RIS has adopted a methodology based both desk analysis of both quantitative and qualitative information
- The integration of desk analysis with a bottom-up approach was made possible by the comparison and documentation activities carried out as part of the Italian "National multilevel co-managed coordination of active ageing policies" Project (2019-2022)



The Italian review and appraisal process within the National multilevel co-managed coordination of active ageing policies project



April 2019 - October 2020

- The National Coordination project established the national network of central and regional Public Administrations, social parties and other civic society organizations
- Information collection on policies, regulations and actions on active ageing carried out in Italy in recent years.
- Identification of connections with the implementation of the SDGs of Agenda 2030
- Discussion about the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic

November 2020 - March 2021

Drafting of recommendations for active ageing policies in Italy

April 2021 – October 2021

- Participatory implementation of the recommendations,
- Drafting of the National Report on the implementation of the MIPAA/RIS

April 2022 – June 2022

 Review of the Report by the network of Public Administrations and Project stakeholders in view of the Ministerial Conference


