

### Proposed new activity for Programme of Work 2023-2027

#### **Background**

- Existing repository of ageing-related policy information routinely collected through the periodic regional reviews and appraisals of the implementation of MIPAA/RIS
- Representing an invaluable information source on ageing-related policy
- However, this information is not being recorded or aggregated in a systematic and comparative way

#### = Missed opportunity



## **Objective**

to improve the capacity of policymakers to develop policy responses to the challenges of longevity and population ageing, by providing **easy access** to examples of ageing policy across the UNECE region **through a searchable web-based database.** 



### What we can gain from it

- Database will allow users to search for information by country, by policy domain and by policy instrument.
- Database will support member States in addressing the goals and objectives of the 2022 Rome Ministerial Declaration through enhanced access to information on related policy developments in the region.
- Facilitate policy monitoring over time (5<sup>th</sup> MIPAA/RIS cycle)
