Dear Secretary,

We would like to thank you for your kind letter regarding the open session of the Compliance Committee on Wednesday, 14 December 2022, offering the opportunity to Hungary for an online consultation with the Committee regarding the Decision VII/8h concerning compliance by Hungary with its obligations under the Aarhus Convention.

We regret to inform you, that due to the currently ongoing national changes in the public administration – which aims to give higher priority to environmental protection managing together with circular economy and climate change policy – Hungary is not able to attend the meeting on the date suggested by the Secretary. Hungary initiates – if it is suitable for the Compliance Committee – to place Hungary to the open session of its agenda at its next, **78th Meeting on 21-24 March 2023**, in order to facilitate a properly prepared and effective consultation with Hungary.
