I write in follow-up to my email of 6 December 2022.

The Chair of the Compliance Committee has considered the communicant's email of 28 November 2022 in which the communicant has indicated its support for the session on the preliminary admissibility of communication PRE/ACCC/C/2022/191 proceeding next Tuesday, 13 December, as well as the Party concerned's email of 8 December 2022 in which it asked for the session to again be postponed to the Committee's next meeting.

Taking into account the views expressed, and bearing in mind the very exceptional circumstances of the ongoing military invasion of Ukraine by the Russian Federation, the Chair of the Committee has decided that the session on preliminary admissibility should be further postponed until the Committee's seventy-eighth meeting (Geneva, 21-24 March 2023).
