As you may recall, in my email of 10 September, I indicated that I would write again in the lead-up to the Committee's 77th meeting (Geneva, 13-16 December 2022) to seek the views of the Party concerned and the communicant on whether each would be in a position to proceed with the open session on preliminary admissibility at the Committee's 77th meeting.

I accordingly write to inform you that, unless either the Party concerned or communicant notifies the secretariat by next Friday, 2 December, that it is not in a position to proceed, the Committee proposes to hold an open session at its upcoming 77th meeting to determine the preliminary admissibility of communication PRE/ACCC/C/2022/191 (Ukraine).

In that case, the open session on preliminary admissibility would be held during the morning of Tuesday, 13 December, and both the Party concerned and the communicant would be entitled to participate virtually in that session. Further details regarding the exact time for the session would be sent together with the meeting's provisional timeline in the week beginning 5 December.
