

TRANSBOUNDARY RIVER BASIN MAP




EXISTING FORMS OF WATER RELATED COOPERATION IN ZAMBIA

- MULTILATERAL
 - SADC REVISED PROTOCOL ON SHARED WATER COURSES
 - ZAMBEZI WATERCOURSE COMMISSION (ZAMCOM)
 - LAKE TANGANYIKA AUTHORITY (LTA)

POLICY AND LEGAL POSITION ON WATER COOPERATION BY ZAMBIA

POLICY AND LEGAL FRAMEWORK

- 2010 NATIONAL WATER POLICY
- PROVIDES A FRAMEWORK FOR THE MGT OF TRANSBOUNDARY AND INLAND WATER RESOURCES MGT
- PROMOTES REGIONAL COOPERATION ON SHARED WATERCOURSES
- WATER RESOURCES MANAGEMENT ACT
- WRM ACT NO 21 OF 2011, SECTION 55 TO 59 PROVIDES FOR MANAGEMENT OF SHARED WATER COURSES AND WATER RESOURCES THROUGH COOPERATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF INSTITUTIONS.
- COOPERATION MAY BE IN FORM OF BILATERAL AND MULTILATERAL COOPERATION.
- THIS CAN ACTUALISED THROUGH TREATIES, CONVENTIONS, DECLARATIONS AND AGREEMENTS FOR EXAMPLE SADC REVISED PROTOCAL ON SHARED WATERCOURSES AND CONVENTION ON SUSTAINABLE MANAGEMENT OF LAKE TANGANYIKA.

POLICY AND LEGAL POSITION ON WATER COOPERATION BY ZAMBIA

Water Resources Management (WRM) Act No. 21 of 2011:

□ WRM NO 21 OF 2011 SECTION 56(1) WHICH STATES THAT "SUBJECT TO THE CONSTITUTION AND THIS ACT AND NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, THE MINISTRY RESPONSIBLE FOR WATER RESOURCES MAY, ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNMENT-

(b) IN COOPERATION WITH OTHER RIPARIAN STATES, DEVELOP LEGAL INSTRUMENTS, ON THE ADVICE OF THE AUTHORITY AND ANY APPROPRIATE AUTHORITY, THAT MAY BE REQUIRED TO PROTECT AND CONSERVE THE WATER RESOURCE AND FOR THE—

(i) USE OF WATER;

POLICY AND LEGAL POSITION ON WATER COOPERATION BY ZAMBIA

(ii) MONITORING AND CONTROL OF POLLUTION AND ITS EFFECTS IN ANY SHARED WATER RESOURCE;

(iii) THE PUTTING INTO PLACE OF ADAPTATION MEASURES TO DEAL WITH CLIMATE CHANGE; AND

(iv) CONTROL OF LONG-RANGE TRANSPORT OF POLLUTION;"

- OBSERVER STATUS GRANTED TO ZAMBIA IN JULY, 2022


- THE RATIFICATION OF INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENTS ACT NO 34 OF 2016






DESIRED WATER COOPERATION STATUS IN ZAMBIA
