RESPECTING RULES ON THE USE OF THE TACHOGRAPH AND ON DRIVING AND REST TIMES IN CASE OF NON-COMMERCIAL HUMANITARIAN TRANSPORT OPERATIONS

Over recent days, IRU has been contacted by several of its members with a request to clarify the obligations of drivers in respect to their driving and rest time rules obligations related to humanitarian transport operations, following the earthquake in Syria and Türkiye.

Below is IRU's analysis and recommendation, based on the provisions of the relevant AETR Agreement and EU rules.

ANALYSIS

According to the provisions of the AETR Agreement (Article 2(f)) and the EU legislation (Regulation 561/2006v, Article 3(d) and Regulation 165/2014, Article 3.1), vehicles used in emergencies or rescue operations, including in the non-commercial transport of humanitarian aid, are exempted from complying with the driving and rest time rules and the obligation to use tachographs.

As a matter of fact, in the case of transports to/from Türkiye, the provisions of the AETR Agreement would normally apply. When these transports are non-commercial transports of humanitarian aid, these are exempted from the provisions of the AETR Agreement.

When these vehicles, which may occasionally be involved in non-commercial humanitarian transport operations, resume performing commercial transport operations, they must respect the driving and rest time rules provisions, and be able to show to control authorities evidence of their previous activities of driving out of scope of the AETR.

According to the provisions of Article 12bis of the AETR Agreement, when driving a vehicle out of scope of the AETR Agreement, such as non-commercial humanitarian aid, it is possible to make use of a dedicated attestation form, to document the fact that the vehicle and the driver have been involved in an out-of-scope operation (non-commercial humanitarian aid), in order to facilitate roadside checks.

The model of this form is provided in Appendix 3 of the AETR Agreement (attached to this note as Annexe 1), which also gives guidance on how to complete the form (attached to this note as Annex 2).

According to the provisions of paragraph 4 of Article 12*bis*, these forms "shall be accepted at any roadside check carried out in the territory of Contracting Parties to this Agreement".

A similar Attestation form exists under EU legislation (attached to this note as Annex 3). As indicated by the European Commission services, this form comes only in addition to the tachograph records and should reflect activities which may not have been recorded via a tachograph¹.

The AETR Attestation form is explicitly designed for justifying periods exempt from the provisions of the AETR Agreement, as laid down in paragraph 1 of Appendix 3 AETR: "The Attestation of activities is to be used when a driver has been on sick leave or annual leave or when he has been driving a vehicle exempted from the scope of the AETR as defined in article 2 of this Agreement".

All the fields in this form must be completed and signed both by the company representative and the driver in order to be valid. For self-employed drivers, the driver signs once as the company and once as the driver. The text of the form may not be modified. Only the signed original is valid. The form may be printed on paper containing the company logo and contact details, but the fields containing the company information must also be filled in.

The AETR Attestation form can be downloaded in English and French.

RECOMMENDATION

It is therefore recommended to transport companies, whose drivers are currently engaged in non-commercial humanitarian transport operations that are exempted from the provisions of the AETR Agreement and the EU driving and rest time rules, to fill in and make use of the AETR Attestation form provided for in Appendix 3 of the AETR Agreement or the EU Attestation form, if applicable, and keep them available on board of their vehicles for control purposes, when engaged in subsequent commercial transport operations in scope of the AETR Agreement or the EU driving and rest time rules.

It is also recommended to professional drivers to present the completed and signed Attestation form to control officers during roadside checks.

Should a tachograph be available on board of the vehicle used for non-commercial humanitarian aid, the driver must record the information about driving out of scope in the tachograph.

Annex 2 – Guidance on how to fill in the AETR Attestation form (Appendix 3 of the AETR Agreement)

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Model forms

In accordance with article 12 bis of this Agreement, road carriers may use the following model forms to facilitate roadside checks:

 The Attestation of activities is to be used when a driver has been on sick leave or annual leave or when he has been driving a vehicle exempted from the scope of the AETR as defined in article 2 of this Agreement.

Instructions for use

(To be reproduced, as much as possible, on the reverse of the form)

- (a) All the fields in this form must be filled in, **before the journey**, by the transport undertaking and the driver concerned.
- (b) The text of the form may not be modified.
- (c) In order to be valid, the form must be signed both by the authorized representative of the transport undertaking and by the driver himself. For individual undertakings, the driver signs once on behalf of the undertaking and once as the driver. Only the signed original is valid.
- (d) The form may be printed on paper containing the undertaking's logo. Sections 1 to 5 may be preprinted. The signature of the undersigned may not be replaced by the undertaking's stamp but may be accompanied by it.
- (e) Any additional national or regional information must be included on the reverse of the form.
- (f) If this form is drawn up in a language other than English or French, the title, in the national language, must appear below the English and French titles, which must be retained. The section headings in the body of the form must be repeated in English when the original document is drawn up in a language other than English (see attached model).
