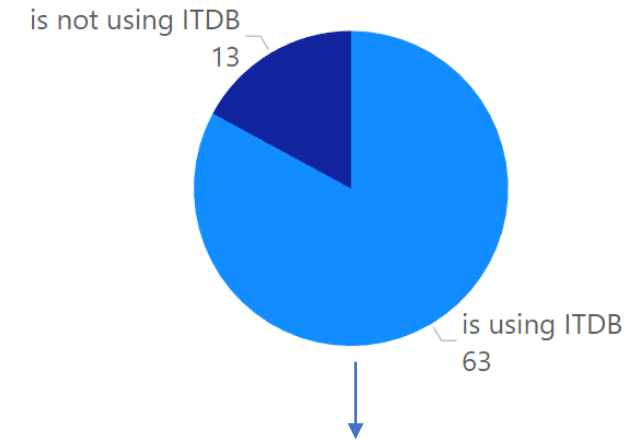

## General ITDB data status

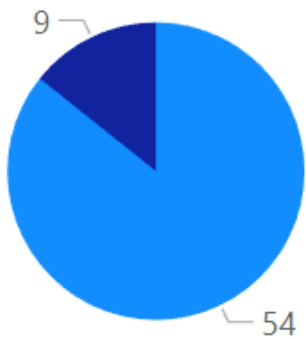
- 1,160 web application users *(since 2018)* +11

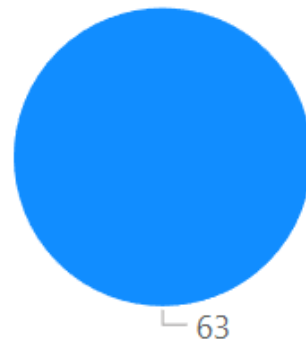
Contracting Parties with ITDB users since 2018



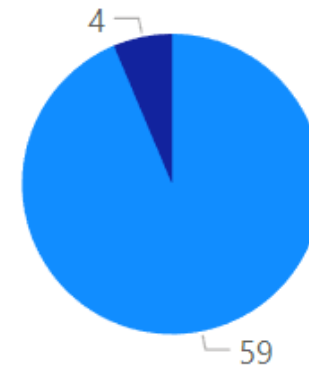
Active Contracting Parties with holder data



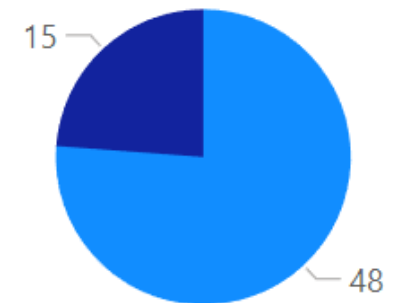
Active Contracting Parties with Customs or Nat. Associations users

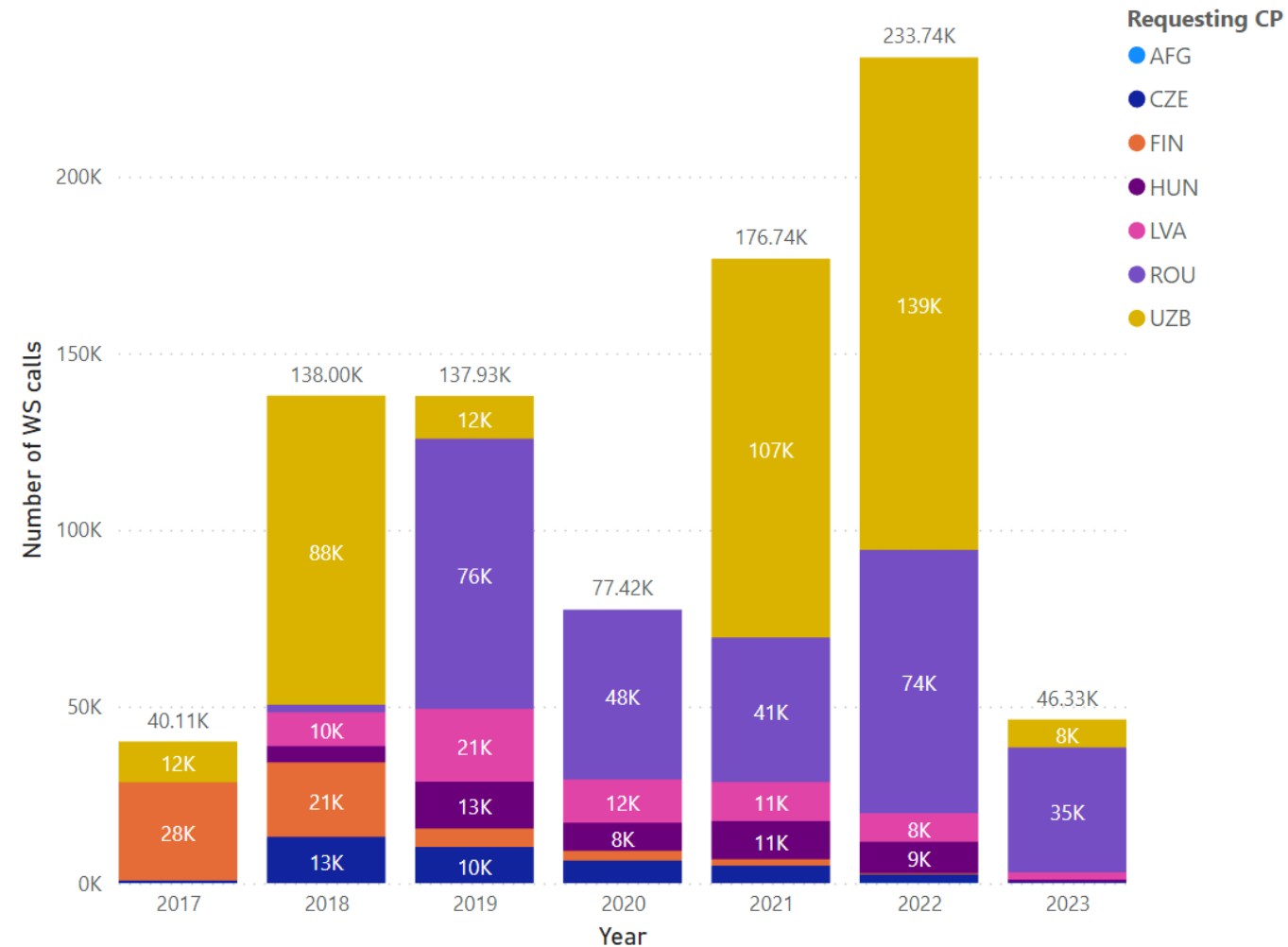

## ITDB web service status

- Approximately 138,000 web service calls per year in 2018 and 2019.
- 77,700 WS calls in 2020.
- 176,710 WS calls in 2021.
- 233,740 WS calls in 2022.
- 46,330 WS calls so far in 2023.

## Recent achievements

- Completed the eTIR Mobile apps User Acceptance Testing
  - UN cyber security validation before publication in Google Android and Apple iOS app stores.
- eTIR Portal in production as of 30 January 2023.
- Yearly reminder on ITDB data update sent to all customs authorities and national associations.
  - Communication to be sent to national associations for holders without email address
- Integrated map data with UNECE Observatory geographical information system (GIS) with ITDB and eTIR mobile apps
- Integrated eTIR international system (“E5 - Query guarantee” message allowing to consult TIR Transport data)

## Future releases and other activities planned for mid 2023

- Deploying eTIR Mobile apps in production (currently planned for February 2023).
- Expanding eTIR Portal and eTIR Mobile apps languages
- Supporting eTIR Portal launch (user adoption)
- Continue supporting contracting parties in customs office data import.
- Support conformance tests (ITDB data import/updates).
- Continue aligning ITDB with the requirements of the eTIR international system.

### Reminder:

1 Customs authority = 1 to many « customs officers » users

1 National association = 1 to many « association staff » users

1 TIR Carnet holder = 1 to many « holder/transporter staff » users

## Clarifications eTIR Portal registration procedure

- Secured access with 2 step registration validation
  1. New user email address verification  
→ Sent to eTIR Portal new user email address
  2. TIR Carnet Holder approval/validation  
→ Sent to Holder contact email address **from ITDB**



To sign-up in eTIR Portal you need your holder contact email address to be set in ITDB.

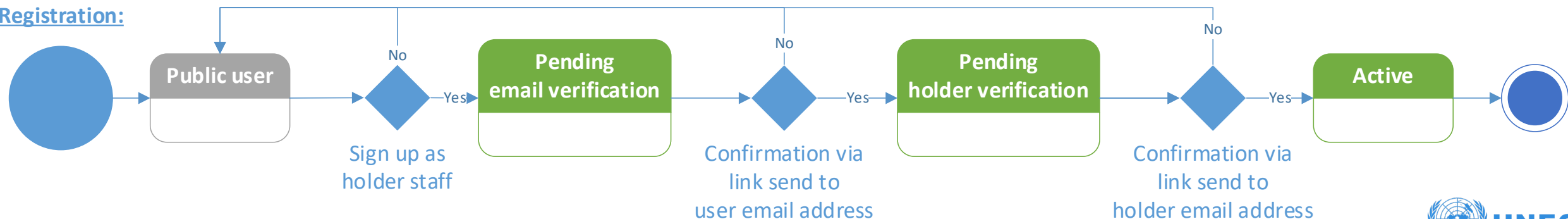
