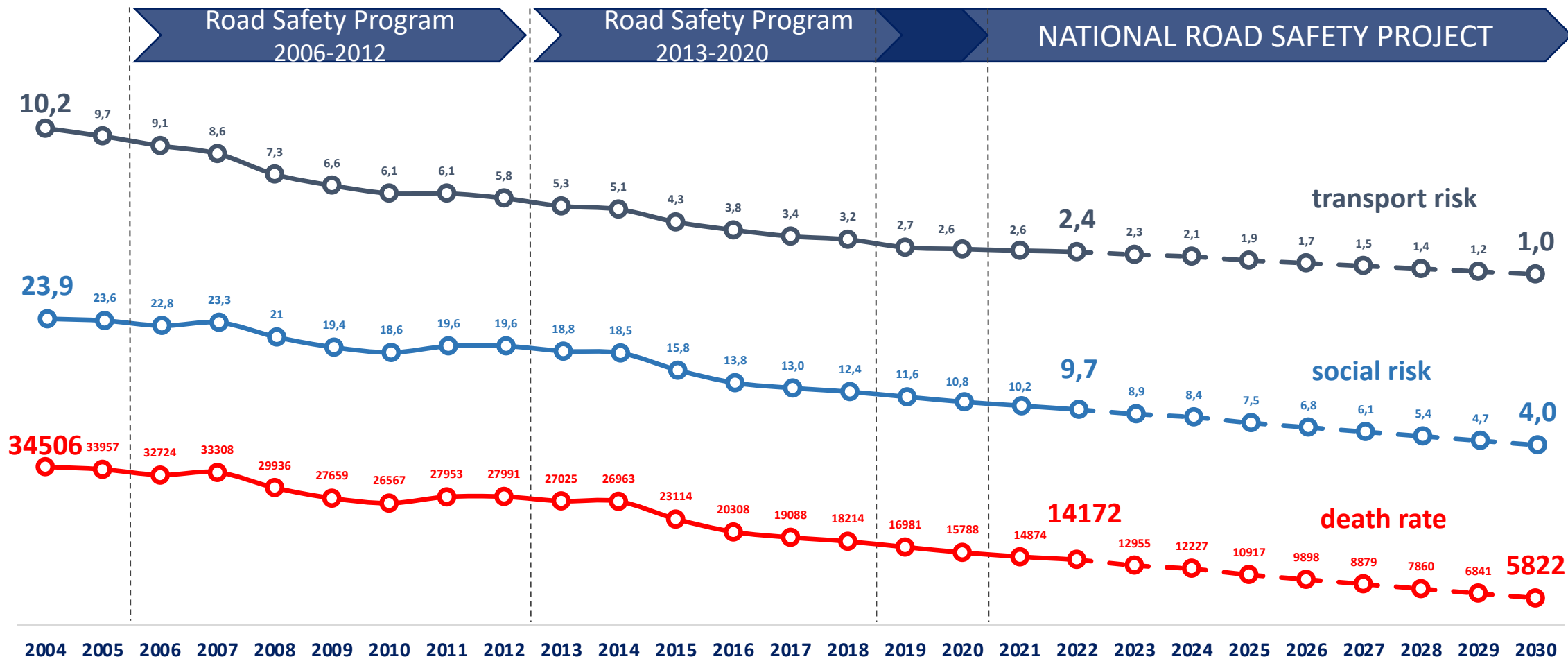

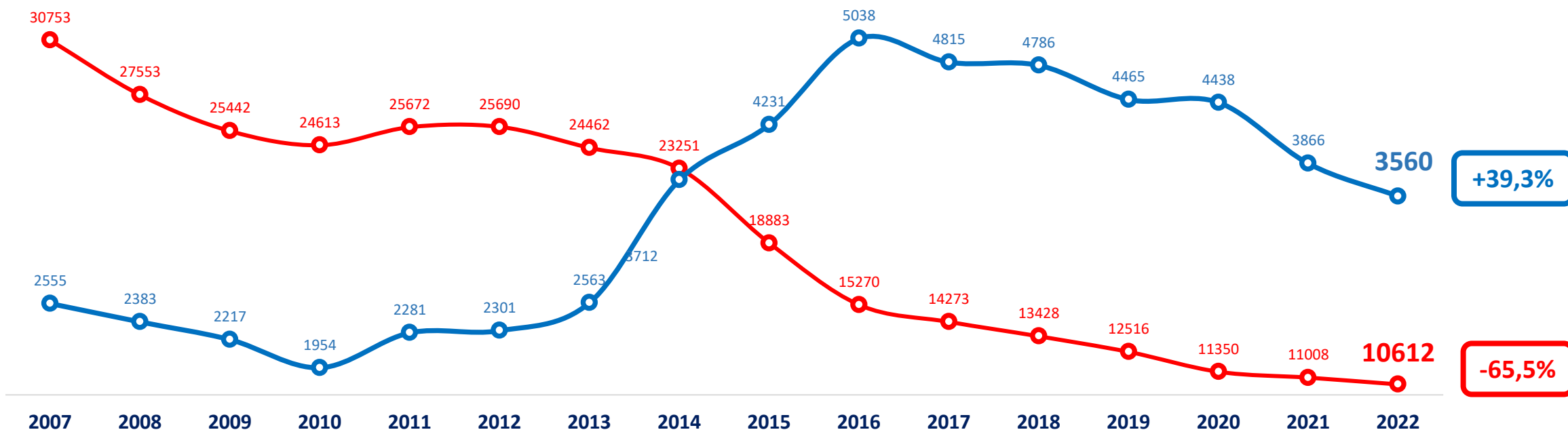


Road traffic accident rate in the Russian Federation is decreasing





The proportion of deaths in accidents involving drivers with signs of intoxication is increasing, while the proportion of deaths in accidents unrelated to intoxicated drivers is decreasing



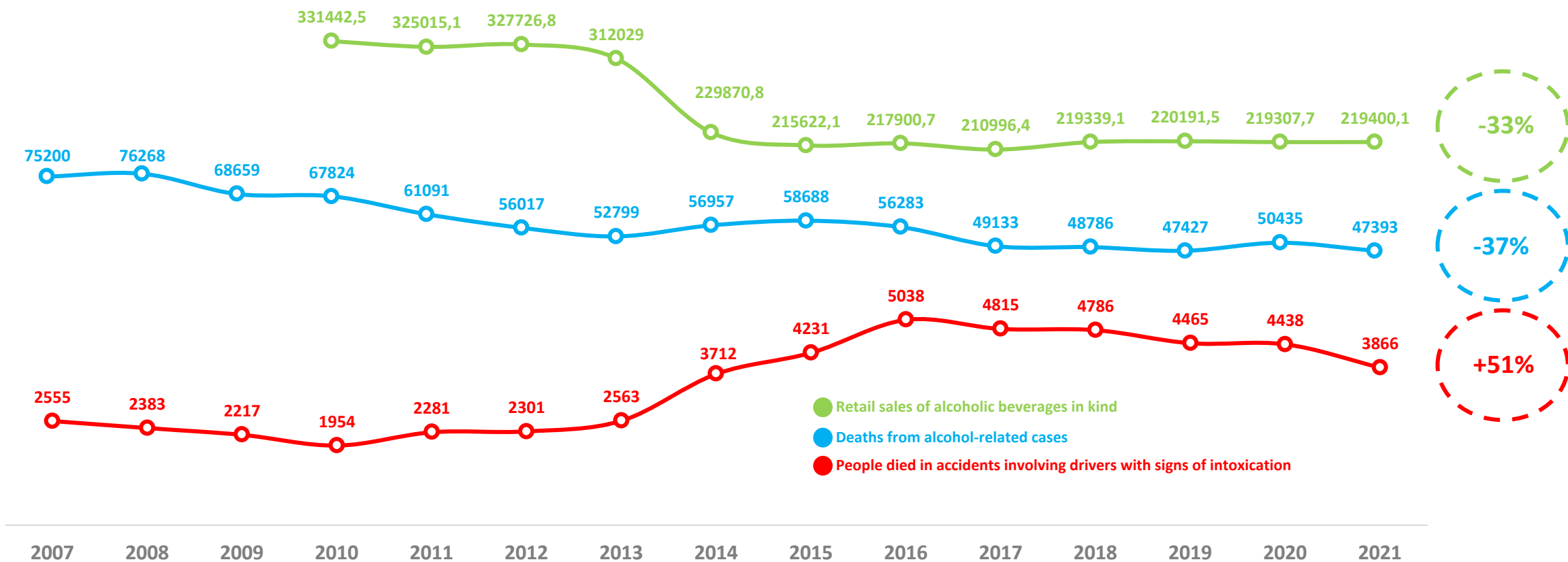

- Deaths in accidents involving drivers with signs of intoxication



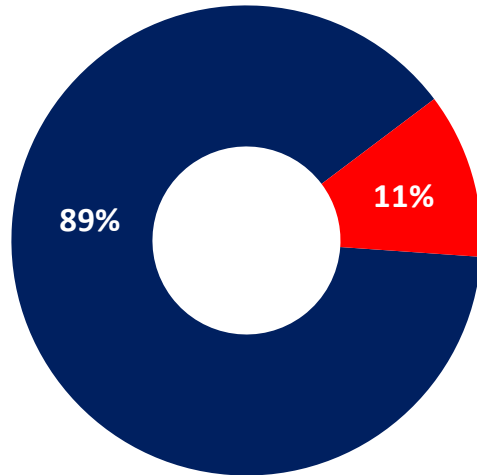
The number of deaths in accidents involving drivers with signs of intoxication is increasing, despite the reduction in the retail sale of alcoholic beverages, as well as the number of deaths due to alcoholic beverages



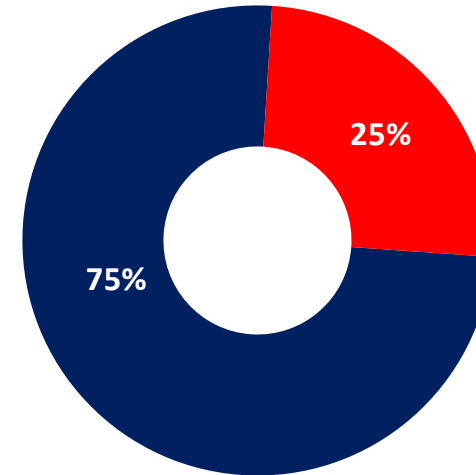


Every fourth person died on the Russian Federation' roads was fatally injured in accidents involving drivers with signs of intoxication

Death rate



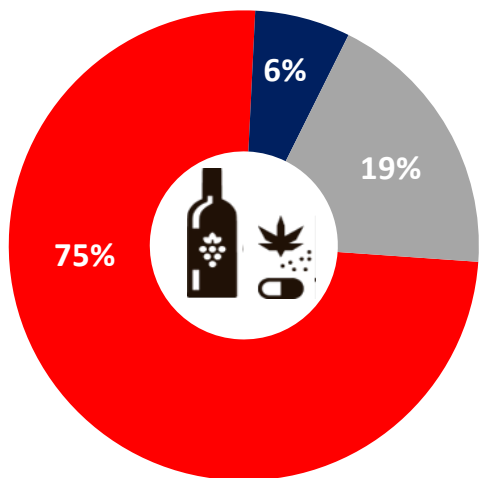
■ without signs of intoxication

Ratio of the number of accidents and the number of deaths in accidents involving drivers signs of intoxication with and without signs of intoxication



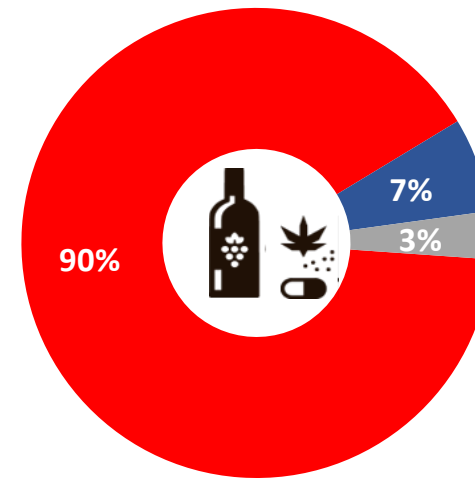
75% were accidents in which the drivers were under the influence of alcohol

Preventive work



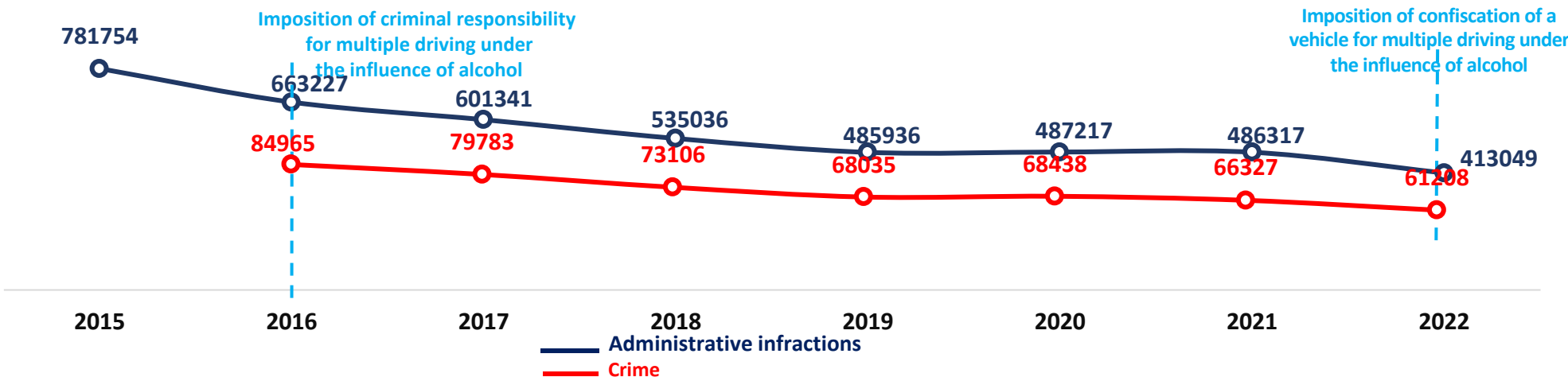
Improvement of law enforcement (conduct of full inspections of drivers for intoxication, modern equipment purchase)



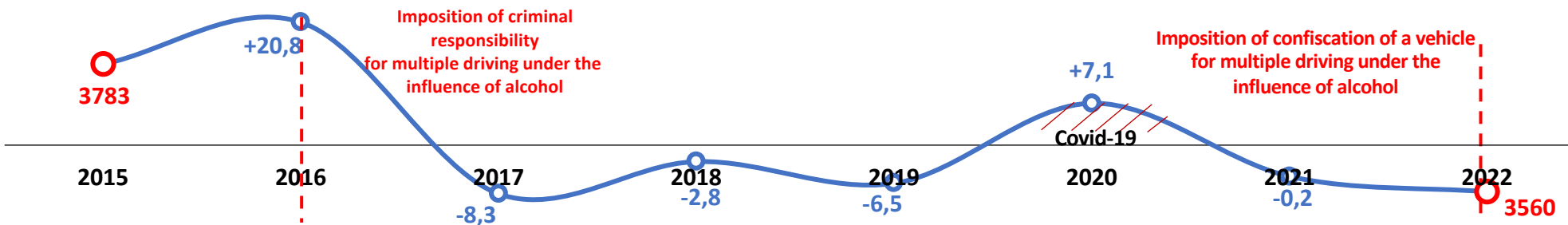
Effective interaction with public health sector



If responsibility for drunk driving is increased, the number of deaths in accidents involving drivers with signs of intoxication will decrease



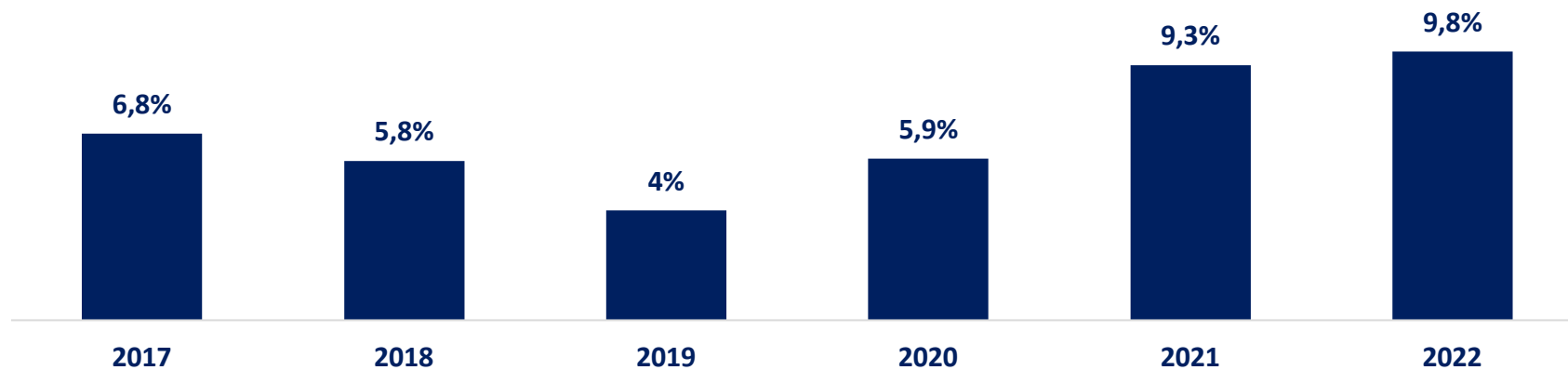
Dynamics of initiated cases of administrative infractions and crimes related to driving with signs of intoxication

One-tenth of intoxicated drivers are identified as a result of processing reports from citizens

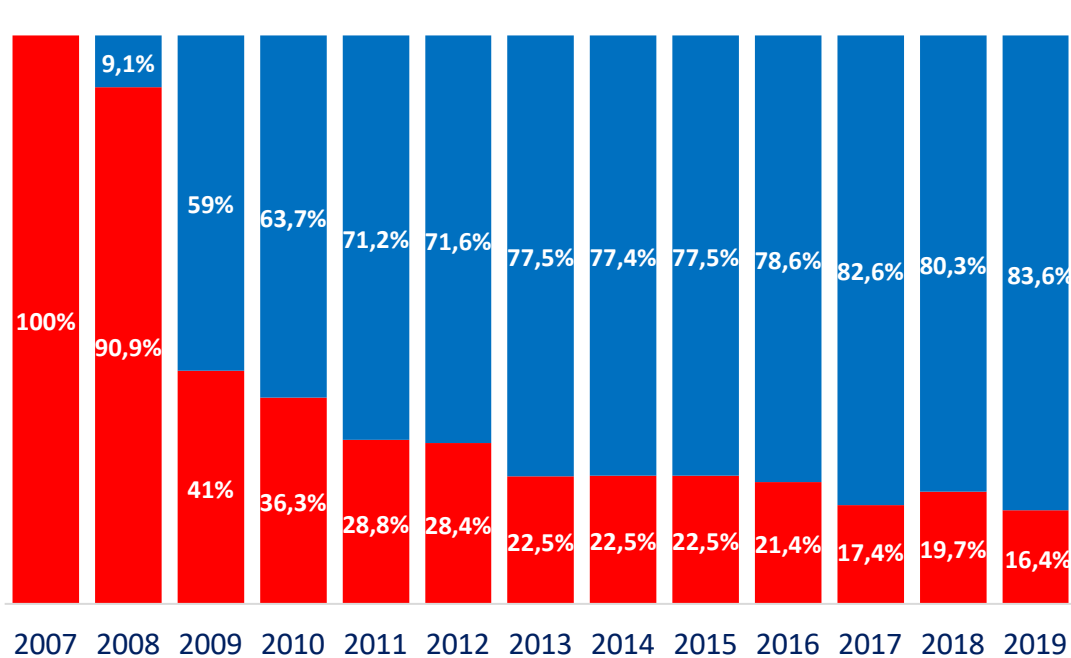

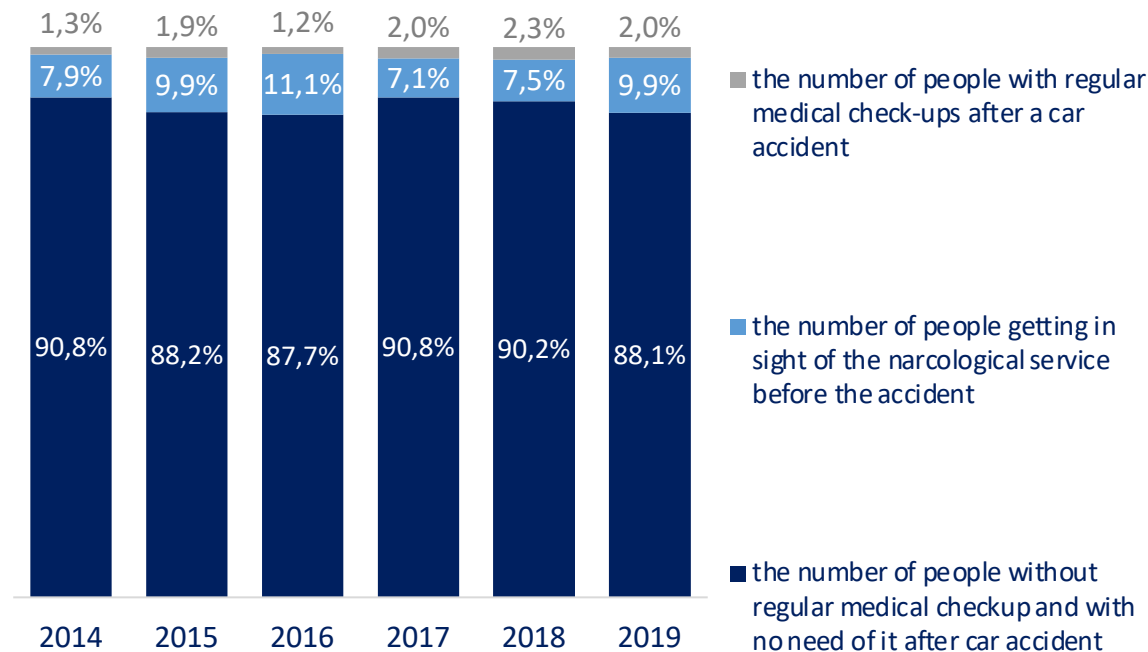

As a result of an interdepartmental experiment on data exchange, it was found that a tenth of those with signs of intoxication came in sight of the narcological service before the accident
