# Introduction



- Different resources are needed
- Large role for coordination and cooperation
- The SDGs were/are seen als development aid
- Responsible ministry: Ministry of Foreign Affairs
- Monitoring SDGs is not part of the regular statistical working program.



# The monitoring process over time (1)



- 2016: first report
  - Based on available statistics
  - The relationships within Statistics Netherlands were key
  - No funding
  - Positive response from society
- 2018: second report
  - Funding from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs
  - More involvement of stakeholders



# The monitoring process over time (2)



- 2019: SDGs integrated in the Monitor of Wellbeing
  - Funding from the Ministry of Economic Affairs
  - No focus on the global indicators
  - Dutch indicators were developed
  - Relationships with the ministries improved
- 2022: Renewed funding for The Monitor of Well-being and SDGs
  - 4 year period
  - Opportunity for additional funding for the SDGs



# Motives for the additional funding



- Specific information to assess which work was needed
  - Amount of global indicators produced by the Netherlands
  - Identifying data gaps
  - Which activities are needed?
- Clarification of the responsibilities of the NSO
  - UN resolution A/RES/71/313
  - Coordination and cooperation
- Specify the resources needed



# How the additional funding is used

- Developing and updating global indicators
- Coordination with SDG focalpoints within the ministries
- Providing country data to custodian agencies
- Contributing to international cooperation





# Lessons learned



- Partnerships and resources are interconnected
- Make the current state of the monitoring really clear
  - Specify the current number of indicators
  - Specify tasks which did not receive the attention needed
  - Specify what could be achieved
  - Specify the resources needed for specific tasks
- Provide context
- Relationships outside of the government
  - Contribute indirectly to obtaining resources
