Questions to Portugal

The Committee acknowledges that in its 2021 NIR Portugal mentioned the existence of a national register/information system that doesn't meet the requirements of the Protocol in particular in terms of searchability and accessibility. The Committee in its 2021 synthesis report had also addressed this topic with a chapter on National pollutant release and transfer registers in the European Union member States (see ECE/MP.PRTR/2021/10, paras. 237-244). Portugal mentioned furthermore that it fulfils its obligation through the E-PRTR and that it is in the process of establishing a national PRTR system to better fulfil the requirements under the Protocol on PRTRs. In this regard the Committee wishes to ask the below questions.

Please provide further information on how Portugal is envisaging to comply with the requirements of the PRTR protocol Please indicate the measures, activities and legislation taken to comply with the requirements of the PRTR protocol. Portugal had experienced difficulties to assure IT assistance on the portal construction due to lack of financial and human resources. Please clarify how Portugal plans to overcome the difficulties encountered in developing the new portal, if any, and when the portal is expected to be finalized?
