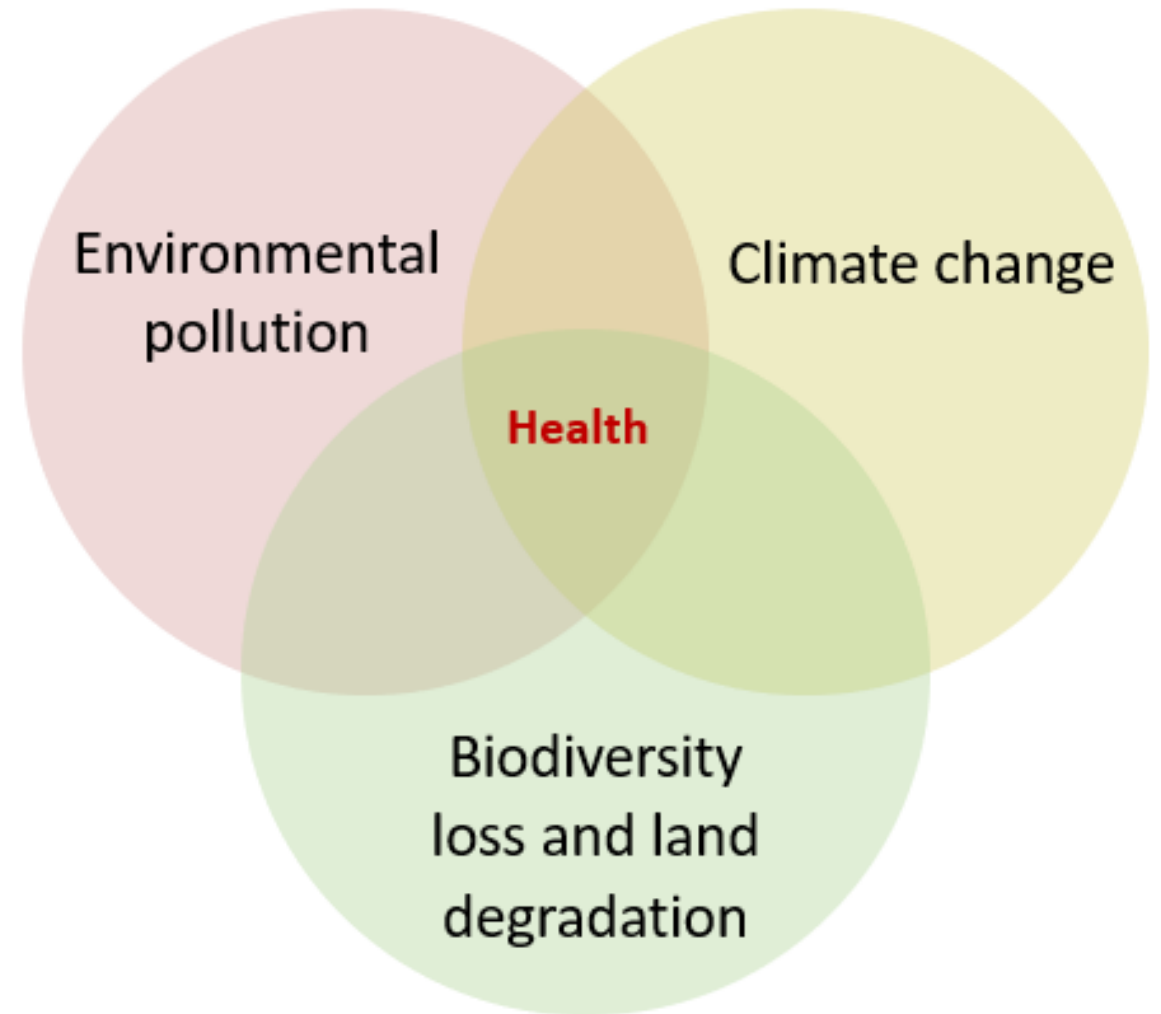

The Budapest approach

Strengthening enabling factors

- improving governance for health and environment;
- investing in human resources for health and the environment;
- advancing knowledge and tools for effective action on health and the environment;
- promoting partnerships for mobilizing joint action on shared priorities.

Prioritizing action on the most pressing environment and health challenges

- climate change;
- environmental pollution;
- land degradation and loss of biodiversity;
- recovering from COVID-19
