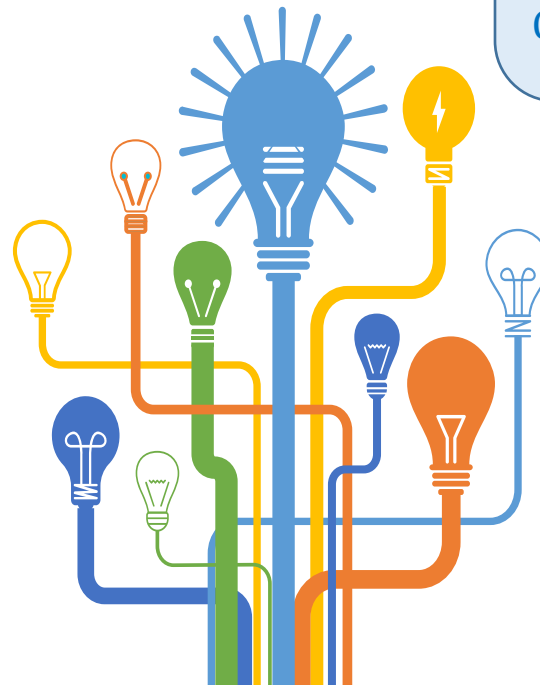

Significant energy price increases are having a negative impact on production capabilities and costs for producers, especially from rural areas

Energy price increases may result in the weakening of the competitiveness of these producers and increasing their vulnerability

Reducing energy consumption can be achieved by improving the efficiency of the food production



Food producers and processors can ensure food safety while being energy-wise and reducing their carbon footprint

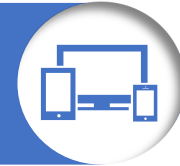

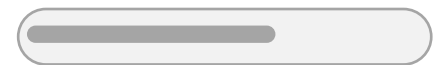
