DETA: The secure internet database for exchanging approval documentation between the Contracting Parties of the 1958 Agreement, as required to be established by the UNECE, according to Revision 3 of this Agreement.

## **DETA** - State of play

### **Facts and figures:**

- 35 Contracting Parties have notified their DETA Focal Point
- App. 42.000 approvals uploaded (+10.000) by 15 TAA

- App. 5770 manufacturers are uploaded and could be selected by TAA
- 14 manufacturers have access to DETA (only to their own approvals) (manufacturer's access is to be requested via their approval authority and to be forwarded to the DETA Administrator)

# **DETA - State of play – Developments**

- Contracting and implementation Unique Identifier
  - → final UI specifications are still discussed
    - → financing again open
    - → considerations at GR's ongoing (editorial amendment of questionnaire WP.29-188-20 (DETA-45-07e\_rev1) circulated to GR's)
- Mass Upload Functionality
  - → implemented in DETA
    (TAAs currently working on implementation within their organisations)
- 2 factor authentication 'with e-mail solution' under consideration

# Extension of scope DETA following WP.29/AC.2 assignment

Access in the course of PTI (1997 Agreement)

→ discussions ongoing in IWG on PTI

Access for Technical Services [performing authoritative tasks]

- → Access to all Certificates provisionally agreed, t.b.c. next session
- → No general access to Information Documents and Test Reports provisionally agreed
- → Access to specific Information Documents and Test Reports by manufacturer permission currently possible
