

Transport and mobility - challenges and opportunities

- > Situation analysis [current transport policies, past mistakes, success stories, new trends, etc.]
- Main challenges [emissions, congestion, noise, safety, poor public transport systems, poor cycling infrastructure, etc.]
- Political, legal, economic, social and technological factors [deficiency of a clear political vision; inadequate legislation and regulations; lack of professional staff, poor monitoring and data collection, insufficient financial resources, etc.]
- A need for a transformation [multiple benefits of healthy, green and sustainable transport and mobility on our wellbeing]




