On 21 February 2022, on behalf of the Compliance Committee, I wrote to forward [communication ACCC/C/2021/189 \(Bosnia and Herzegovina\)](#) for the Party concerned's response to the substance of the communication.

In accordance with the five-month deadline set in paragraph 23 of the [annex to decision I/7](#), and as stated in my letter, the Party concerned's response was due no later than **21 July 2022**.

As you will be aware, the five-month deadline for the Party concerned to provide its response to the communication is set by the Meeting of the Parties in decision I/7. It is therefore not a flexible deadline. However, as of tomorrow, 21 March 2023, the response of Bosnia and Herzegovina to the communication will be eight months overdue.

Accordingly, if the Party concerned has not in fact yet submitted its response to the communication, the Committee requests that it do so immediately.
