


# EC-funded Extrabudgetary Project in support of UNFC & UNRMS



- “Supporting UNECE member States in the development and implementation of UNFC and UNRMS”
- A Key Focus: Implementation of UNFC in European Union, Europe and beyond
- 4 years (August 2020 - July 2024) / 2 million EUR
- To-date Results and Outcomes: UNFC trainings, documents such as UNFC Guidance Europe, establishment of Network of Practitioners Europe (European expert community)
- Support to use UNFC according to proposed Critical Raw Materials Act across the European Union
