

UNECE-FAO JOINT WOOD ENERGY ENQUIRY 2021 TRAINING WEBINARS

17, 20 & 27 April 2023 15:00-17:00 (GMT+2)

Background:

The UNECE/FAO Forestry and Timber Section, with the encouragement of the Joint ECE/FAO Working Party on Forest Statistics, and in collaboration with the International Energy Agency (IEA), the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) and the European Commission (EC) decided in June 2006 to develop and launch a "Joint Wood Energy Enquiry" (JWEE).

Wood energy data are often scattered or lost within renewable energy statistics, making it difficult to assess and evaluate the real role of wood as a renewable source of energy. The Enquiry aims at improving knowledge and understanding of wood energy consumption and tries to shed light on the potential and future perspective of wood energy in the region.

The JWEE collects data of both sources and uses of wood and promotes cooperation on data collection and assessment between the energy and forest sectors, providing a comprehensive framework on the role of wood energy in member States. The UNECE/FAO Forestry and Timber Section launched the data collection for data for the reference year 2021 on 18 January 2023.

Objectives and structure of the webinar series:

The events aim at providing support national experts to provide a complete dataset on wood energy sources and users in the JWEE for the reference year 2021. The events will particularly provide guidance on how to obtain data from waste and energy statistics and how to fit them into the questionnaire.

The webinars will include interactive segments to provide a platform for active discussion between the secretariat and national correspondents and to facilitate interaction among experts from waste, energy and forestry and two facilitate peer learning between countries. Initially there are three modules planned:

- Module 1 "Overview session Introduction to the Joint Wood Energy and data sources on energy consumption"
- Module 2 "Detailed structure of the Joint Wood Energy Enquiry and how to best obtain relevant national data with a focus on countries in the Western Balkan and Eastern Europe,

 Caucasus and Central Asia"
- Module 3 "Online discussion about specific datapoints and last remaining questions to refine national replies. Discussion with the secretariat and among peers about possible solutions"

Target audience:

National correspondents from forestry, wood products, energy and waste data experts.

Geographical focus:

The webinar is open for all countries in the UNECE region.

National experts from countries in the Western Balkan, Eastern Europe, Caucasus and Central Asia are particularly encouraged to participate.
